Eco Tip of the week

**Plastic Free July has begun - a move-
ment challenging you to give up single-
use plastic for the month!**

1. Save your plastic - It may sound
strange but for the month keep any single
use plastics that you use. This will help
you to track your plastic use and identify
key problem areas to help prioritise your
focus on making changes that will have
the biggest impact. It will also help you to
identify just how much plastic you use.

2. Pick it up - Whenever you are out and
about and you see some rubbish on the
ground, simply pick it up and put it in the
bin (or recycling if applicable). This way
you will help to improve the environment
for you and others and to help prevent pol-
lution and harm to wildlife. Any additional
materials that are recycled will also help to
reduce our demand on resources.
