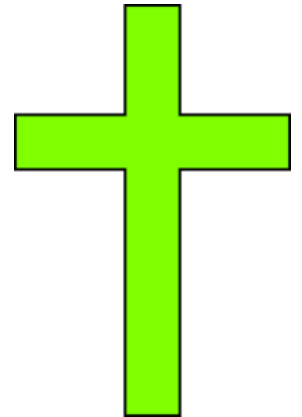

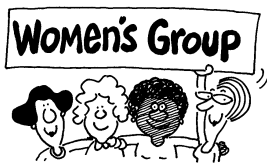

Women's Group

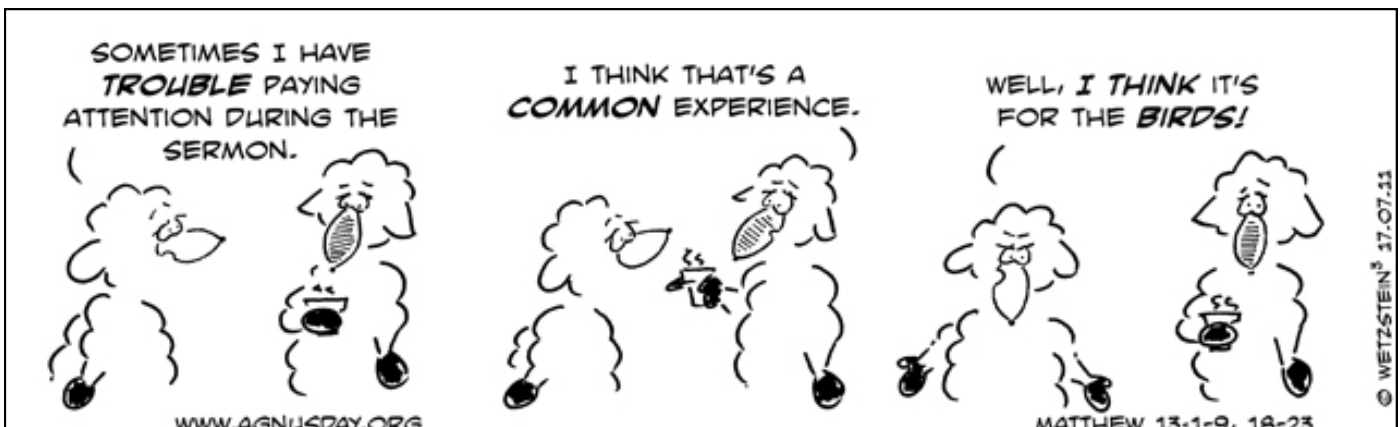
The **Women's Group** meets at the Limes Centre Activity Hall on Thursday at 9:00am (last one before the summer holidays).
