If you're aged 40 – 74 and meet the eligibility criteria below, a **free** NHS Health Check can help you reduce the risks and stay healthy.

The West Sussex County Council Prevention Assessment Team will be offering these **free** checks at Crawley Library.

Health checks are **by appointment only** with the NHS nurses from the Prevention Assessment Team.

For eligibility please see the following criteria:

Not had an NHS health check in the last five years; Not currently taking any prescribed medication for; High blood pressure; Cholesterol; Kidney disease; Stroke; Diabetes; Heart disease; Atrial fibrillation
