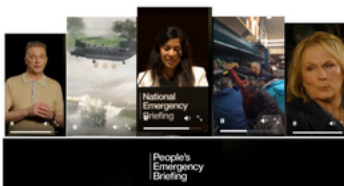

May your church grow as we deepen our love for you and our service to others.

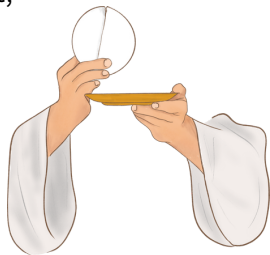
Help us always to remember, though we are many, we are one body, as we all share in you, our one God.
