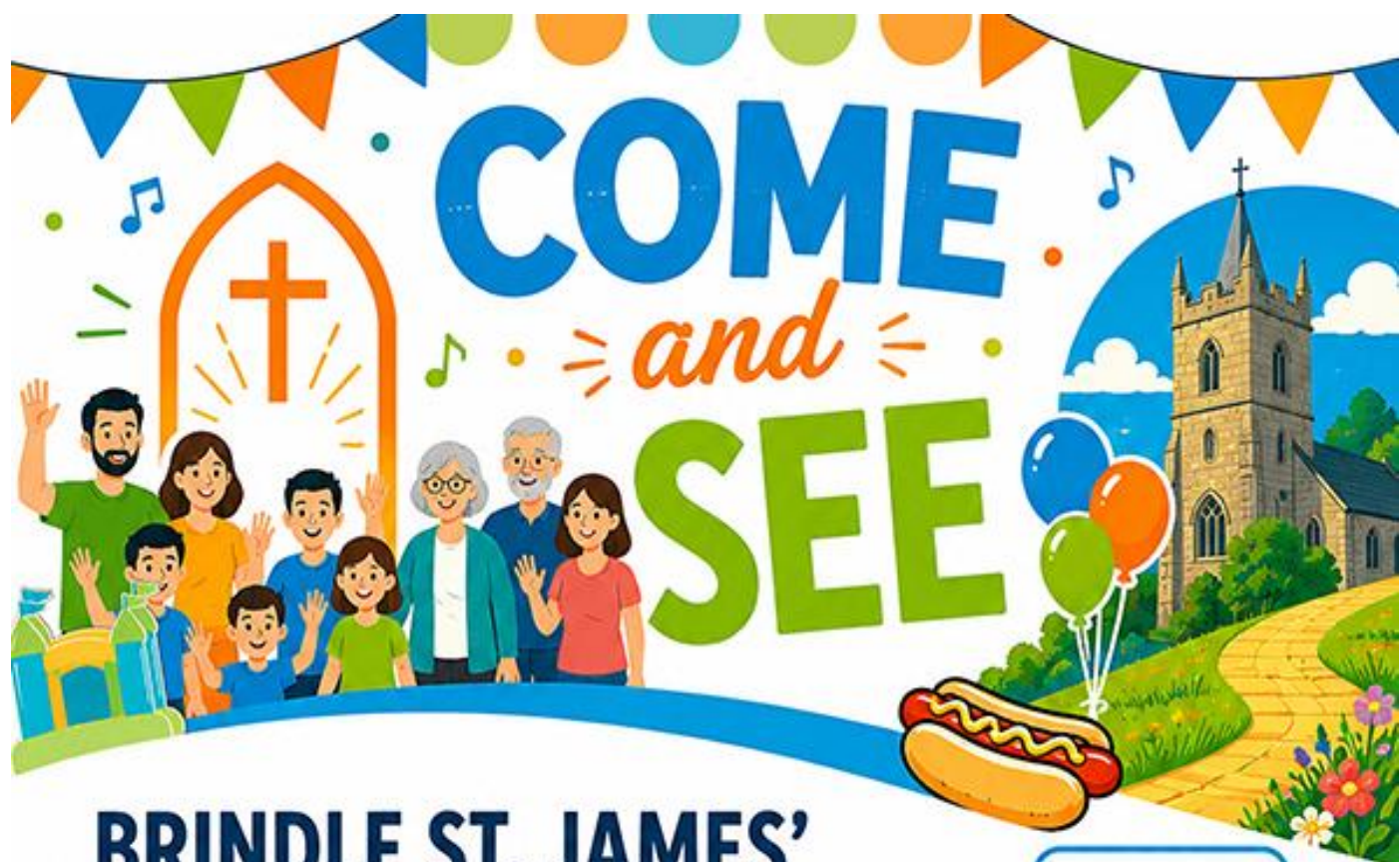
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As the summer holidays continue please consider the families, already struggling, who need to find an extra meal each day whilst their children are at home
