Season of Creation

There has been a growing movement across Christians Churches to mark a Season of Creation in September. It was introduced in 1989 by the Ecumenical Patriarch of the Orthodox Church and adopted by Churches Together in Britain and Ireland in 2008. This year the Church of England introduced the Festival of Creation in Christ on the 1st Sunday in September.



The Season of Creation runs from 1 September to 4 October (Feast of St Francis). Please look out for opportunities, coming soon, to be involved.

Eco Tip of the week

Green cooking

1. Boil only what you need - To avoid wasting water and energy, whether using a kettle or boiling in a pan, only use the water you need. For boiling in a pan you only need enough to submerge your food; steaming your food uses less water still. Use the water that you do use to water your garden and house plants.

2. Freeze leftovers - freezing food is great if you have leftovers that you don't want or won't have time to eat during the next week. You can also use the freezer to store baked goods (eg cake or bread) as well as excess fresh produce. Freezing fruit is very easy and is perfect for using in smoothies or juices or to turn into your own ice cream alternatives.
