Supporting St. Georges Church

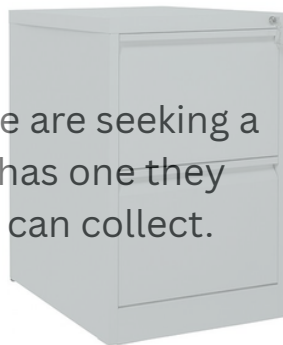
St. Georges Church is wholly supported by its members enabling us to:

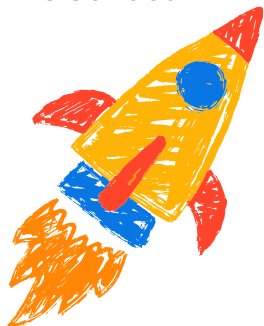
