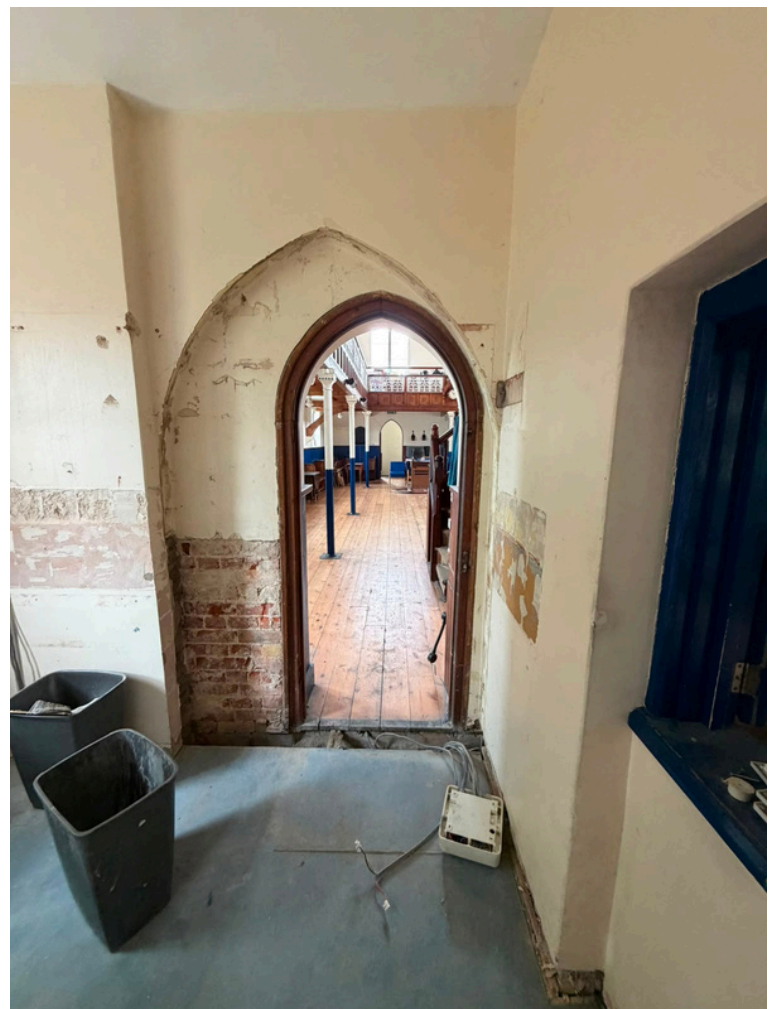
## Clavering Christian Centre Update

Well, the works to restore the kitchen at the Clavering Christian Centre are well under way. The old doorway to what was the vestry (Kitchen) has been reopened and the electrics have been completed. We are now waiting for the kitchen and fitting to take place.

So many people have contributed to this and the Church and URC together have contributed to the fundraising for the work, as well as money from the Bugle magazine as a way of reinvesting the money raised back into the community.

We will be looking to improve storage and seating as well, but this is where I would ask for a little more help. We would like to replace the existing hard, uncomfortable chairs with folding cushioned chairs that are easier to store. We have tried for grants but to this point have been unsuccessful. So we are looking to raise £1500 for the chairs and storage rack. Could you help?

I appreciate that this seems like another ask but this will make the use of the centre even more comfortable. If you feel you can help then please do contact me. But in any case please do visit us we have our launch event in Sept/Oct (Date TBA) and enjoy the new setting. What a blessing the newly refurbished centre will be to all users.
