- **5pm on Sunday 23rd August - St Bartholomew's Day Evensong Service at Barbrook**

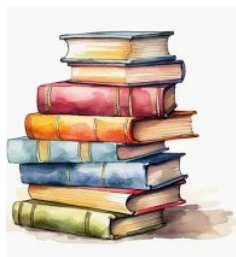
The 5pm Evensong service on Sunday 23rd August at Barbrook will be celebrating St Bartholomew's Day.
