Deanery News

Reverend Canon Christine Goldsmith. It is with deepest sadness that we announce the death of Chris Goldsmith. Chris died in office as Rector of the Wolds Gateway Group and Rural Missioner of North East Lincolnshire. She was also a member of the diocesan Mission Enablers team, and previously served as Rector of Welbourn, Leadenham, Brant Broughton and Beckingham. Chris joined the Diocese of Lincoln in 2019 from the Diocese of Cyprus and the Gulf. In 2025, in recognition of her contribution to our common life and shared journey, she was made a Canon of Lincoln Cathedral. Please pray for Chris’ husband Rick, along with their family, close friends, congregations and colleagues who are mourning this sad loss.

Her funeral details are as follows: Chris will be received into Laceby St Margaret on the evening of Thursday 13th August and she will remain there over night. This will be a private service for her family. Her final journey from Laceby to Riby St Edmunds is on Friday 14th August where she will be met by Bishop Nicholas who will preside over the Requiem mass which will begin at 2.00pm. The committal will be in the churchyard. The Venerable Canon Aly Buxton will preach. It was Chris's wish that her chapter colleagues (Readers, Deacons, Priests) should lead her into Riby Church. Dress code is Alb and White or Gold Stole. (Others are being asked to wear bright colours, yellow if possible). Her church wardens will give her a guard of honour. The service will be live streamed as there are family and friends around the world who will be join us online.

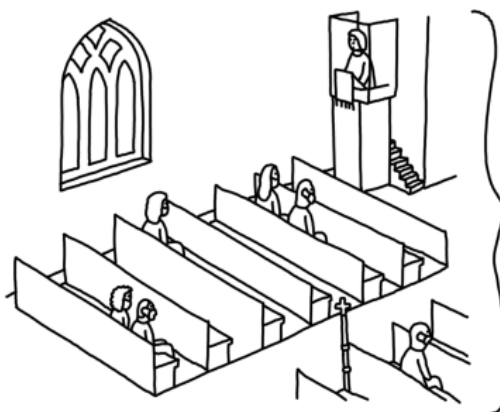

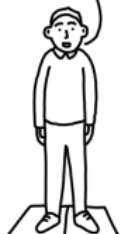

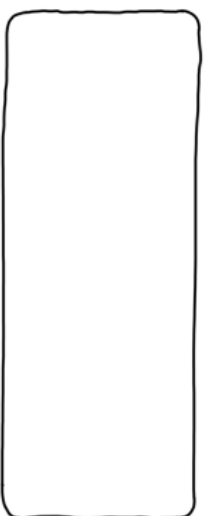

PASTORAL PROVISION

Home Visits / Home Communion (Tuesdays 2pm to 5pm)

The act of receiving communion is a sacred time of fellowship with God. The Lord's death will be commemorated through prayer and meditation during this special time of worship in your home. As we eat the bread and drink the cup, we are reminded of Jesus' sacrifice. Our participation is also a symbol of our union with Christ, as by doing this, we remember what He has done for us, which is what He asked us to do. Once a month, on a Tuesday afternoon, we could come to your house to take communion with you or just have a chat if you cannot attend church for health reasons. As part of this time, we also practise "Dwelling in the Word", reflecting together on scripture and listening for what God may be saying to us. We would love you to join us in prayer.
