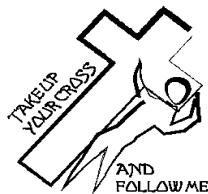
Daily Bible Readings: These readings are related to the Lectionary readings for this Sunday. Try to take time each day to read the assigned Bible passage.

Jeremiah 15:15-21 Psalm 26:1-8	Romans 12:9-end	Matthew 16:21-end
Because he often had to warn people of divine judgement, the prophet Jeremiah faced criticism and unpopularity and complains here to God about his lot. In return, God promises to save and deliver Jeremiah.	Paul wants the Roman Christians to be transformed by Christ in thought and deed. Here he spells out some ways in which Christians should be different.	Peter has just confessed Jesus to be the Messiah, but we now see that he had not understood that this would bring Jesus suffering rather than acclamation.

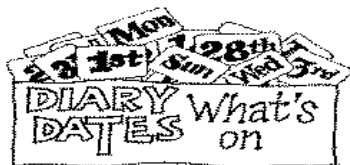
