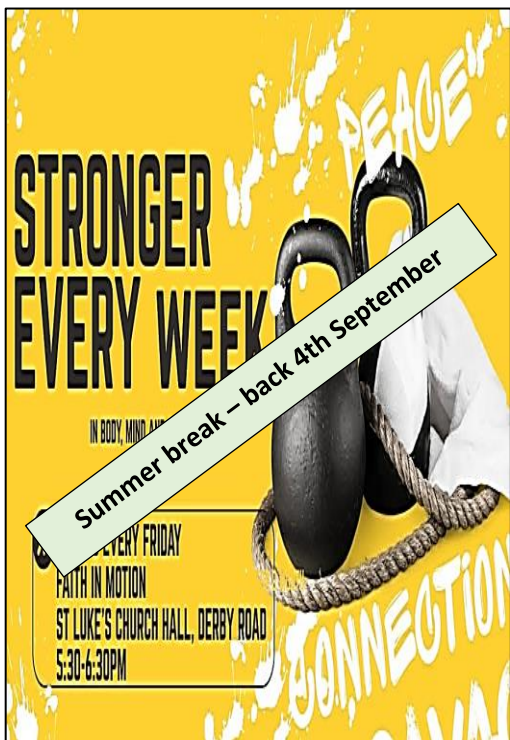
If you are able to bring your own volunteer too, that would probably be useful. The more the merrier, with no previous experience necessary.
