The cost per person for the weekend will be £182.50, with reductions for children, students, a carer accompanying someone and for single parents. There are very few ensuite rooms and there is a small additional charge for those. I am not sure at this stage whether there may need to be a small charge for transport but we will work that out nearer the time.

Please would you put your name on the list at the table at the back of church if you would be interested to come - and do speak to me or Christine or anyone else who came last time if you would like to know more.

If you would like to come but could not afford it, please do talk to one of us, as there may sometimes be funding we can access. Also, if you would prefer to pay monthly, that can be easily arranged.
