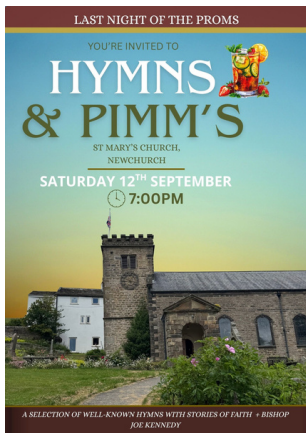

The search for home, a place to call your own, security, significance and purpose have long been the subjects of stories and fables throughout the ages.

Christopher Nolan's version of Homer's Odyssey illustrates that these remain issues that fascinate us. And while it is an ancient story of heroism and leadership the Bible has a story that is older and yet still resonates with us. Over the next 8 weeks we will follow the Bible's own odyssey story as our sermon series considers a series of events in the book of Exodus.

Many of us know the stories of Moses' birth, calling by God and the plagues in Egypt but our series walks us out of Egypt into the desert for 40 years. There the homeless nation of Israel, who had no security, no seeming significance or purpose begin to experience a relationship with God that sets them apart to live lives of radical obedience to God. As they are set apart as His people to be barres of his promise we will see how this call to this mission continues through the church today.
