Informal Welcome

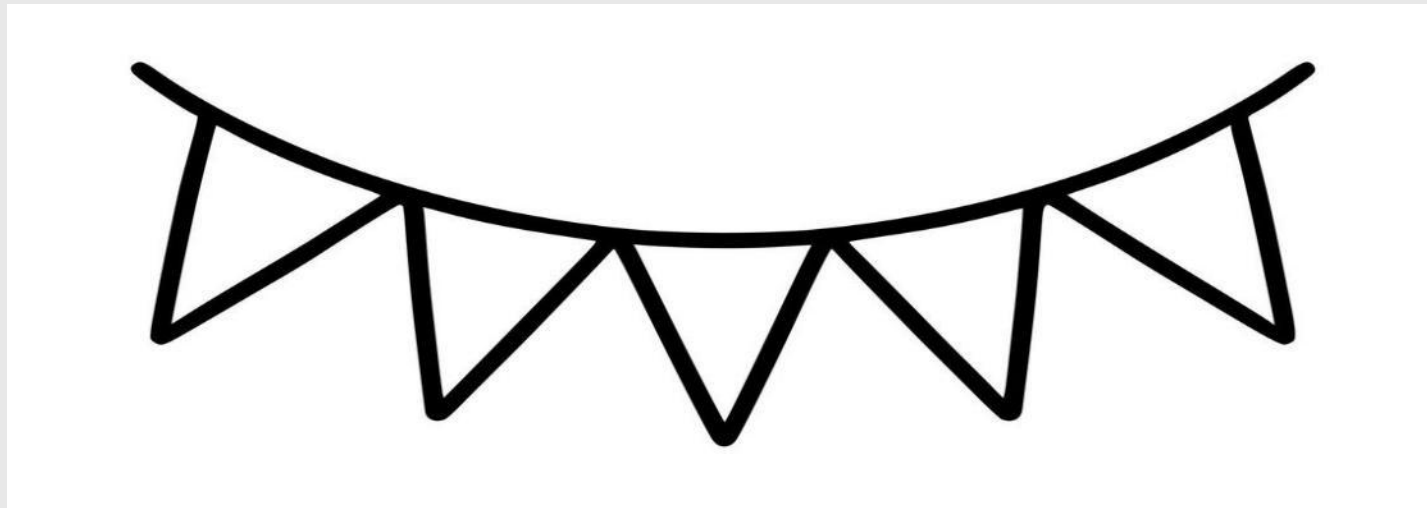
September is a season of new beginnings and new challenges and today we are going to give thanks to God for all that is good and find a secret that will help us in every situation.

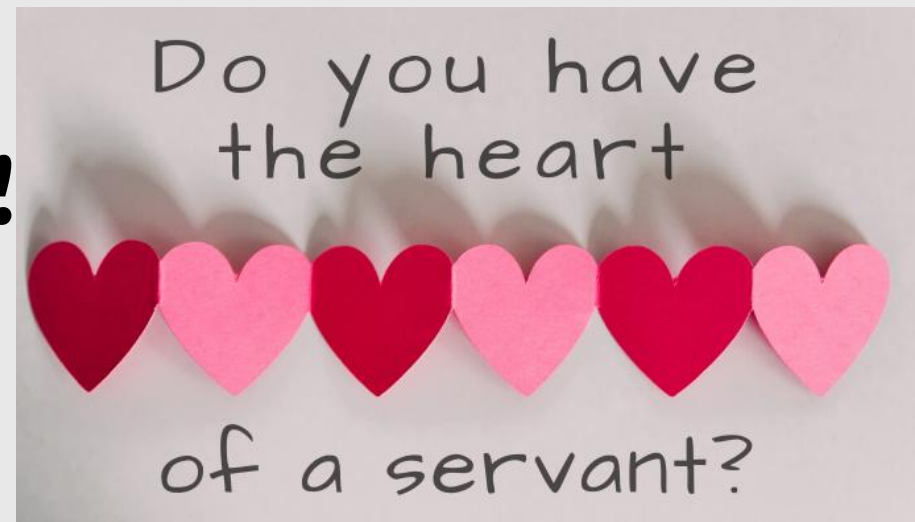

Making connections

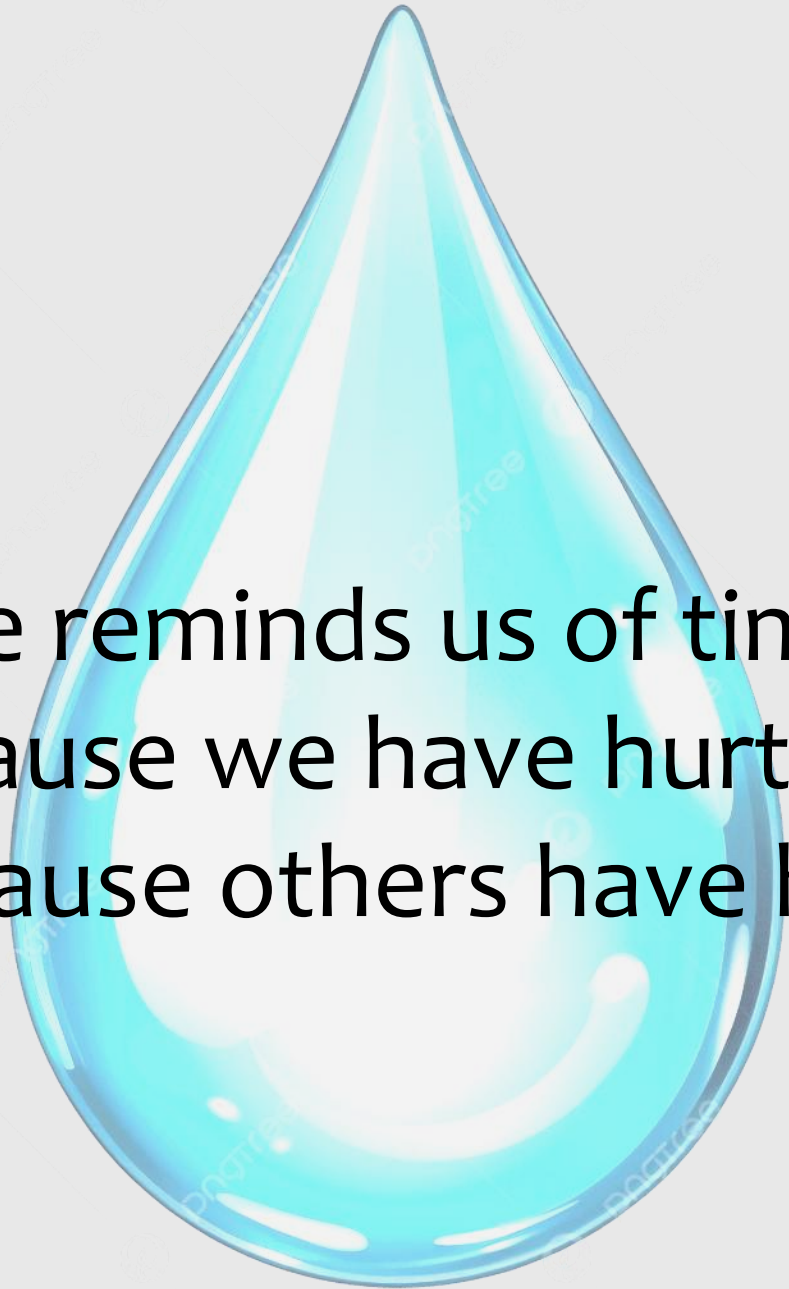
L: When we go through times of change,

but now have life through Christ our Lord.**

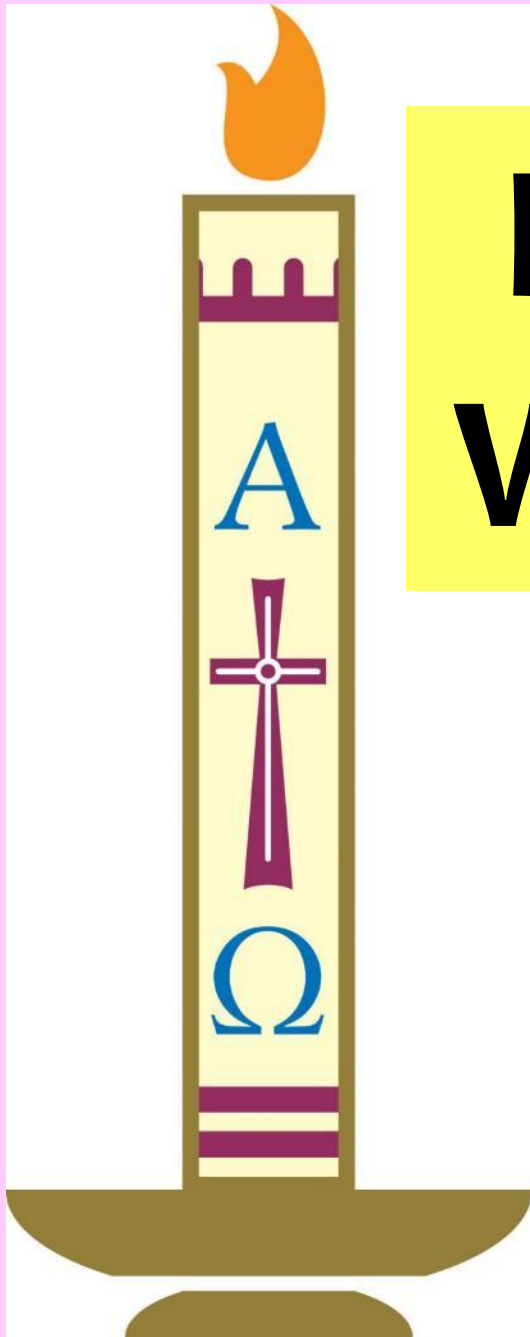

Baptism Welcome



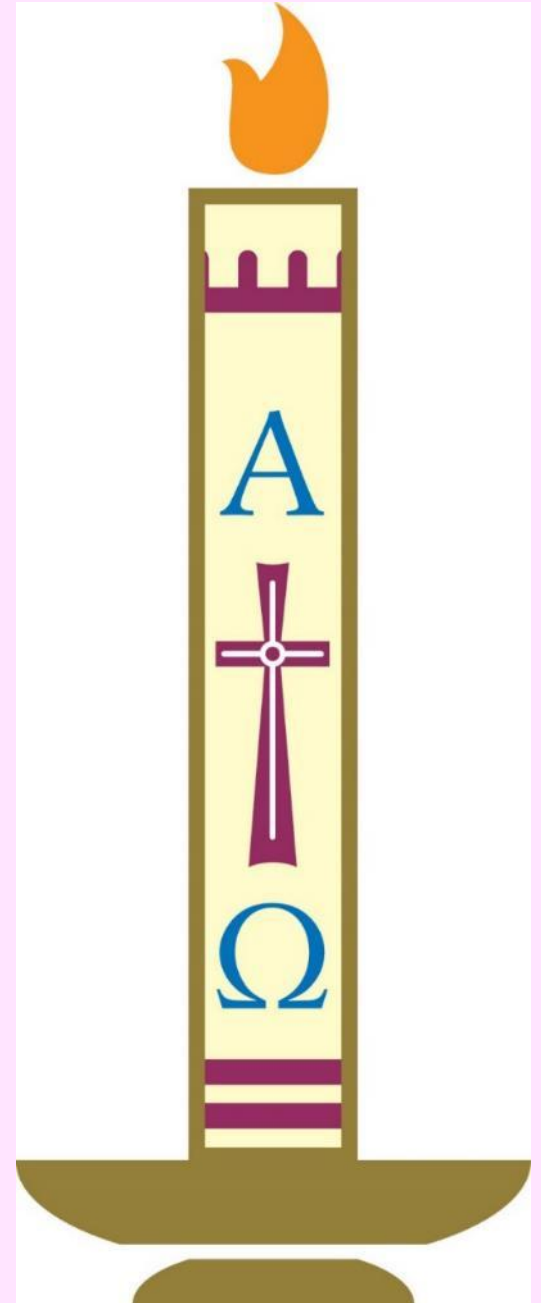
Baptism Welcome

passed from darkness to light.

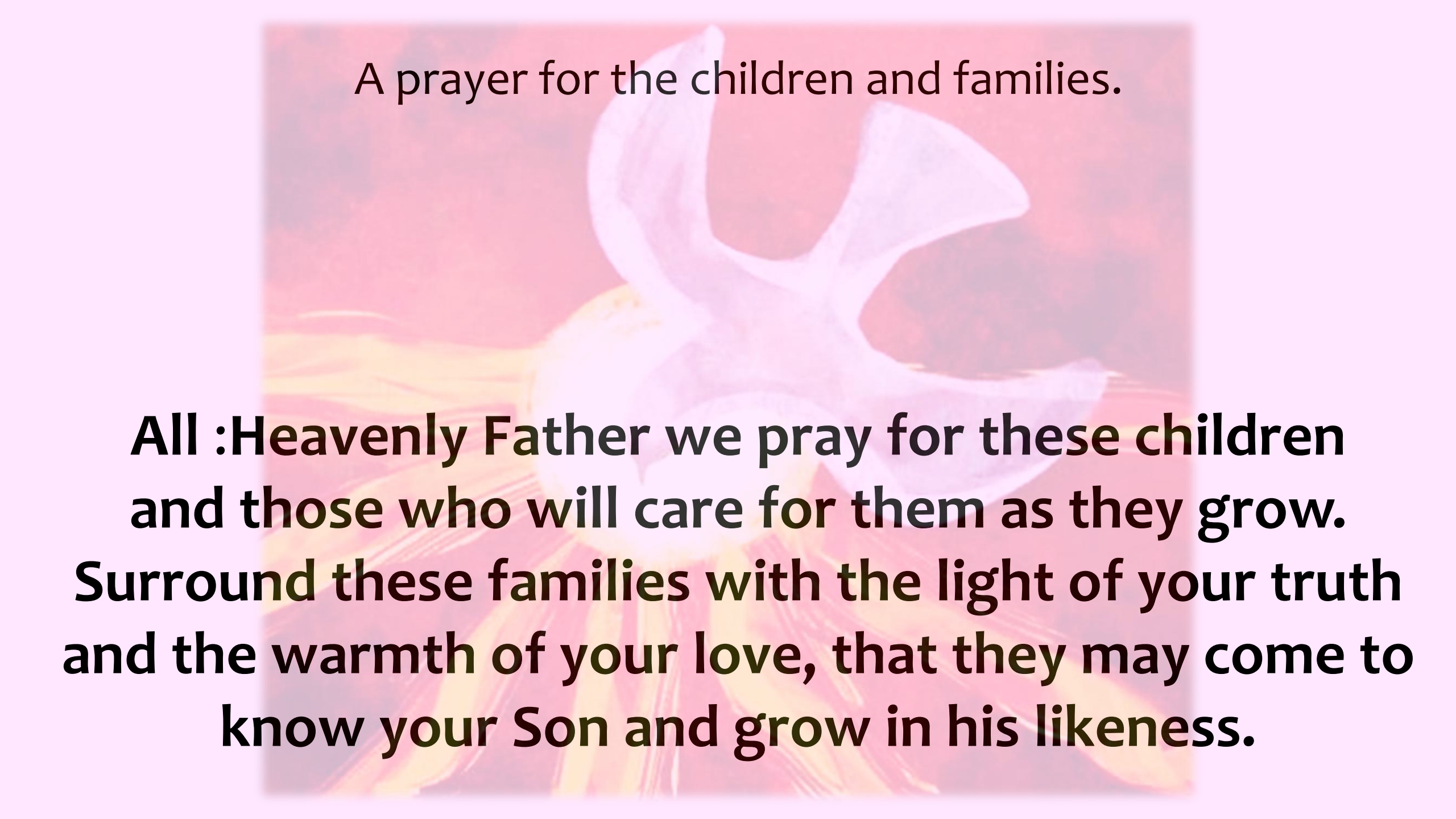
All : Shine as a light in the world to

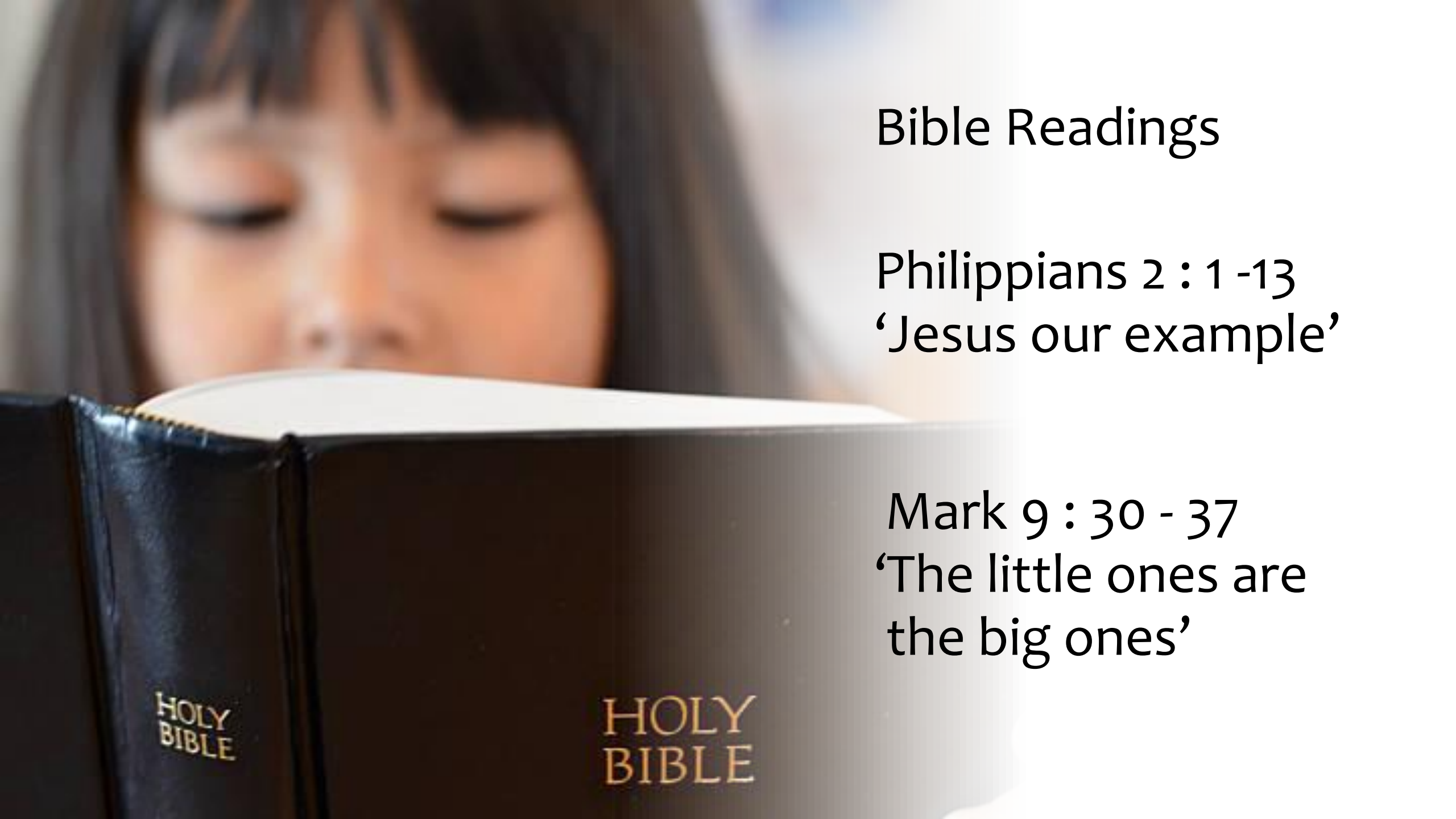

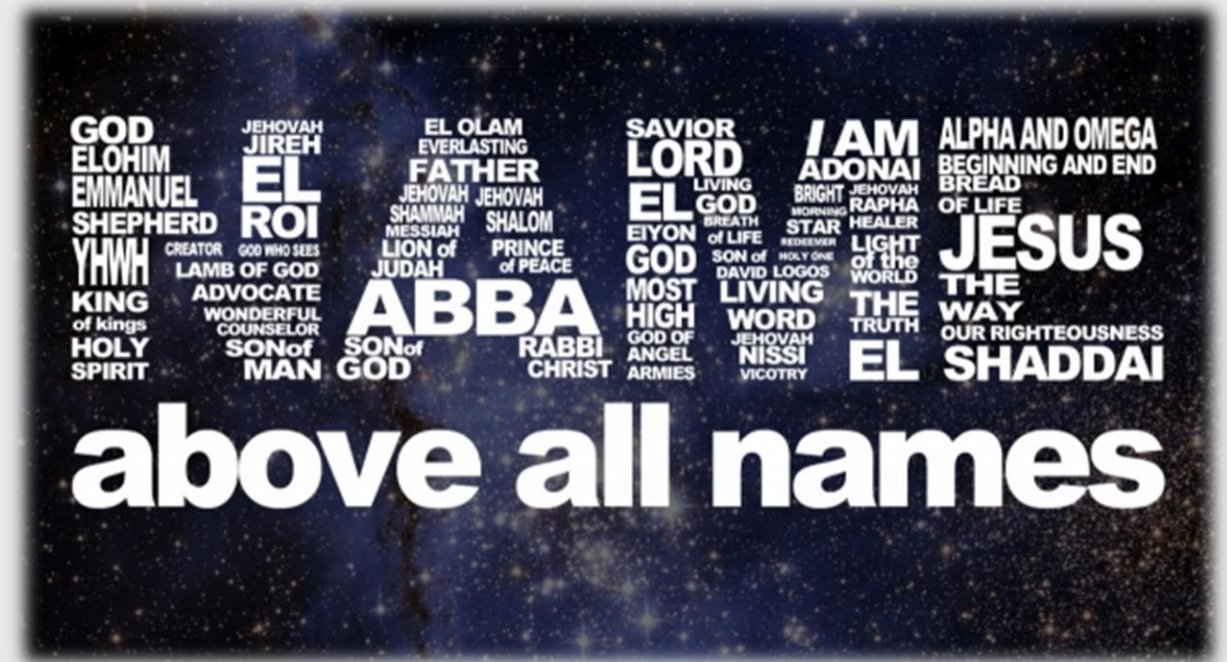

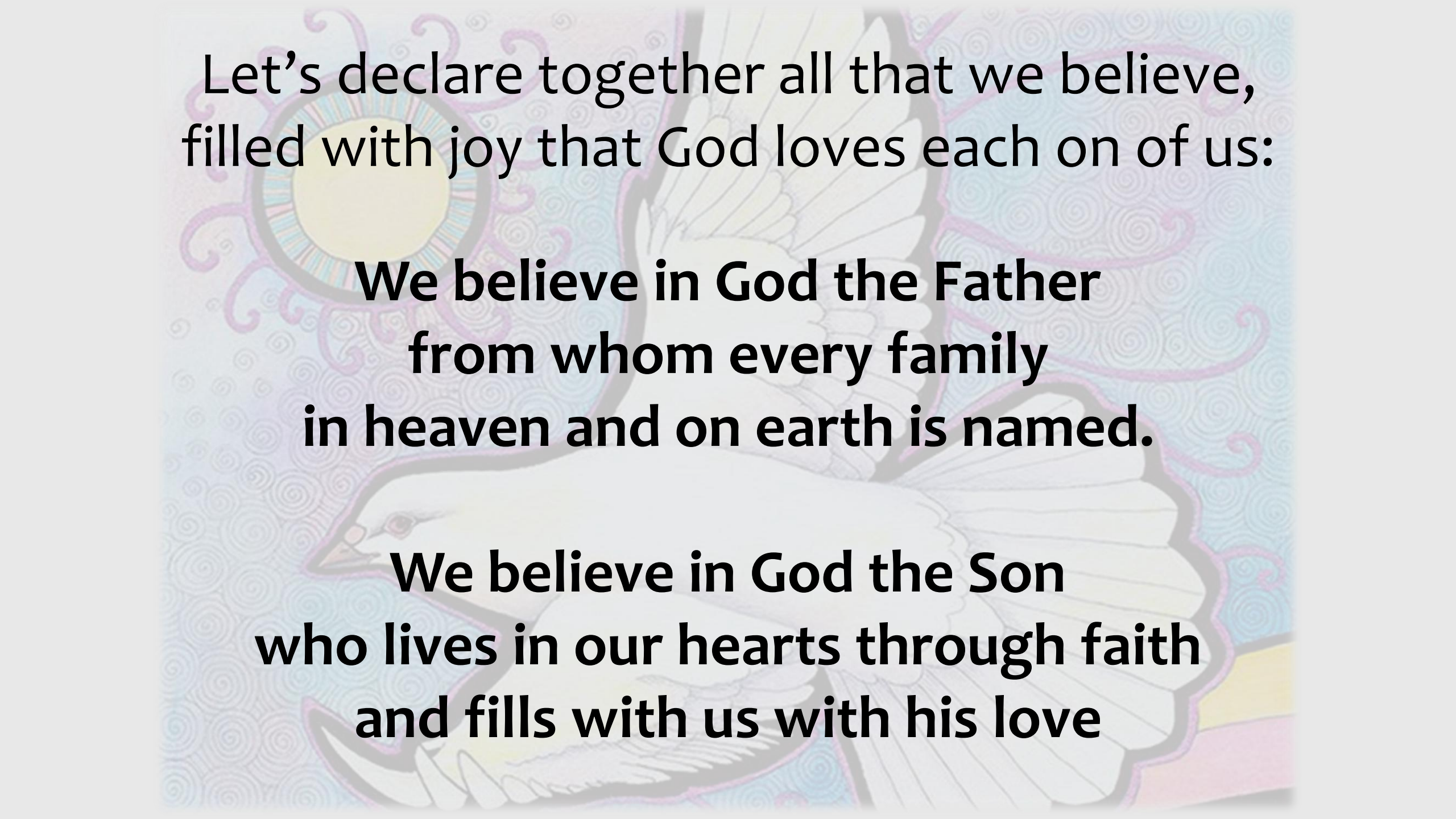

The Creed – we say what we believe



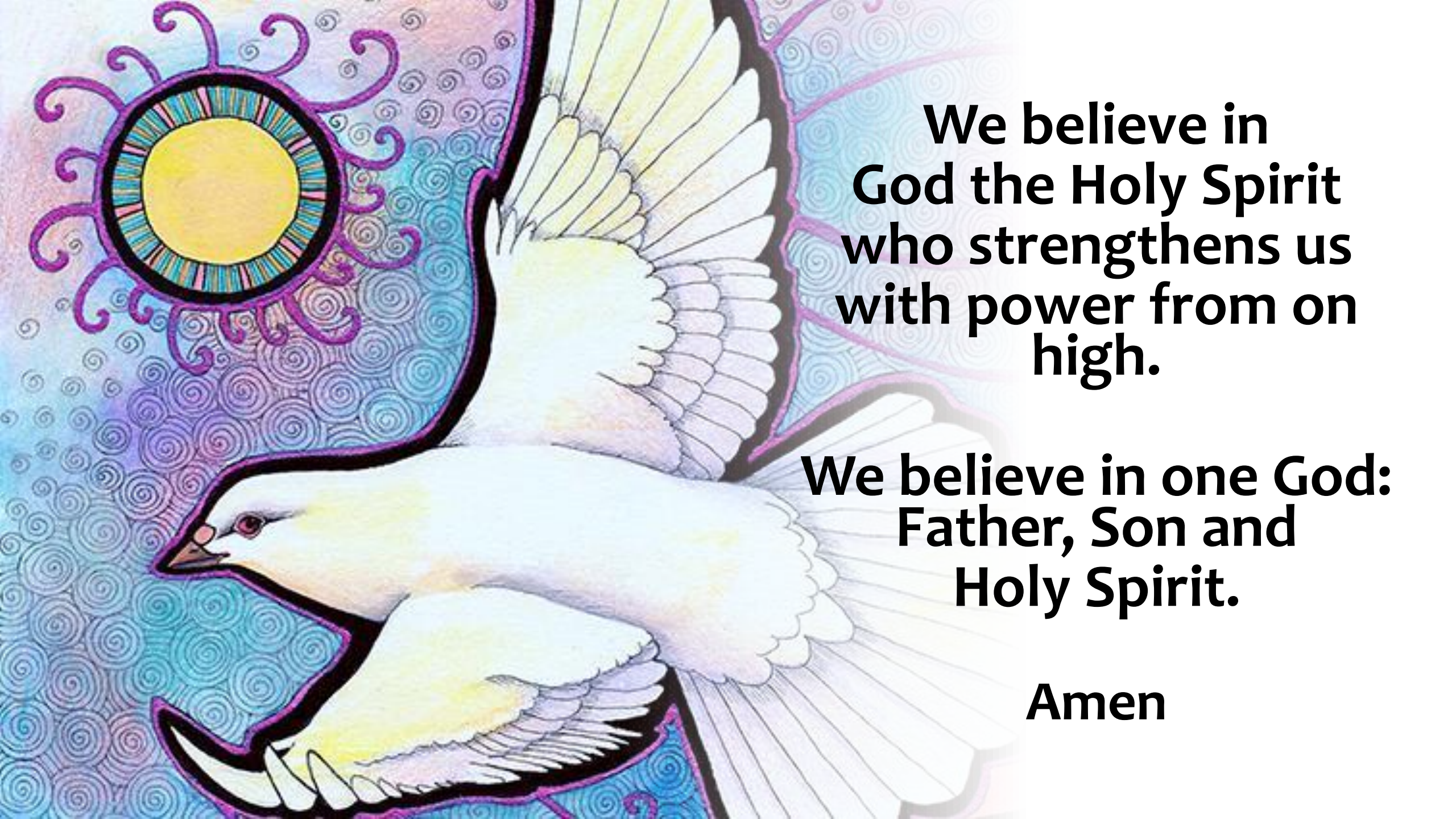
We've thought about how the good news of

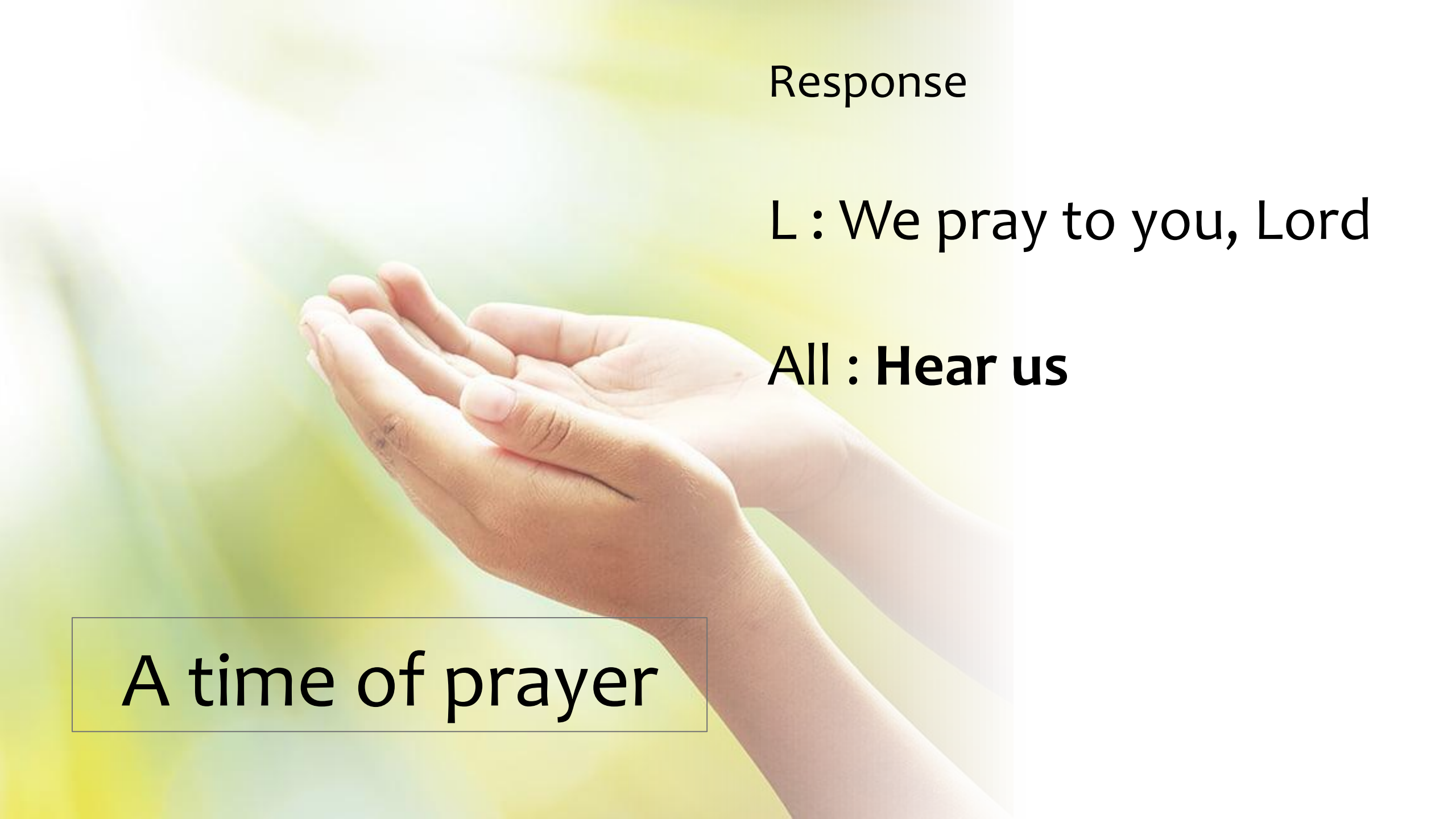

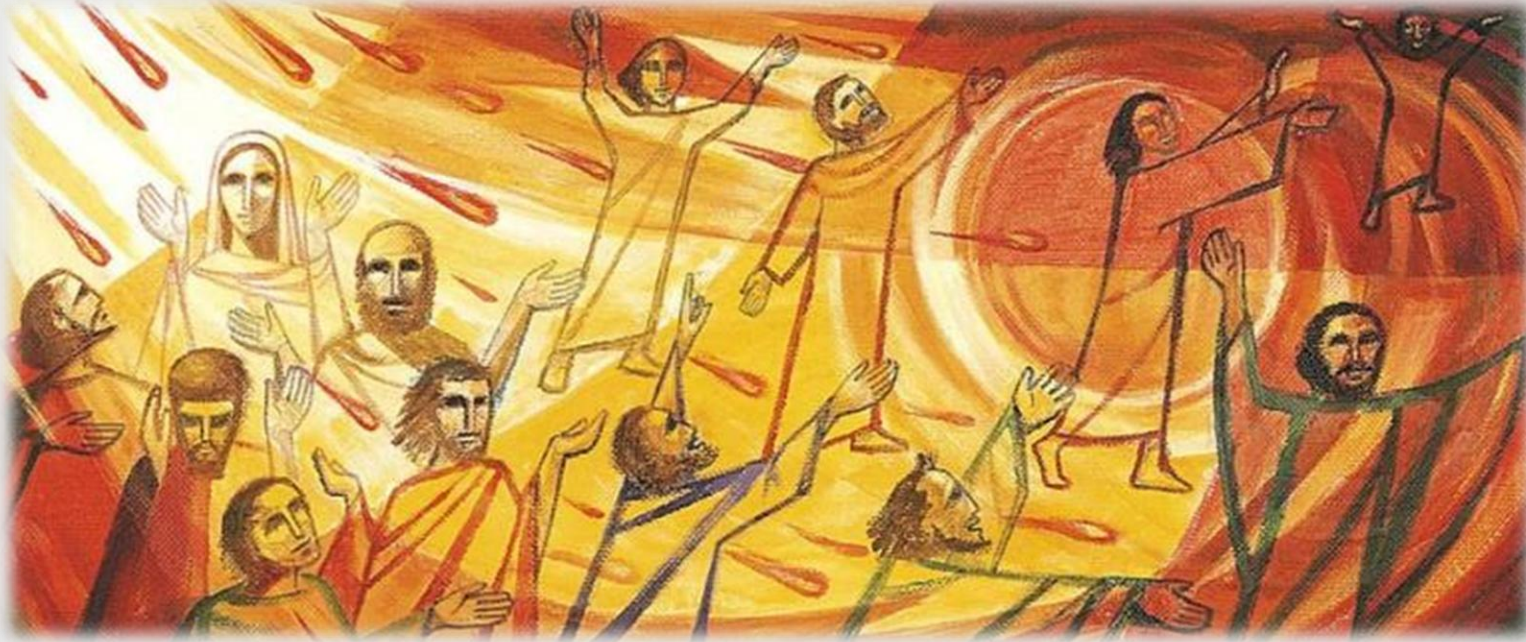

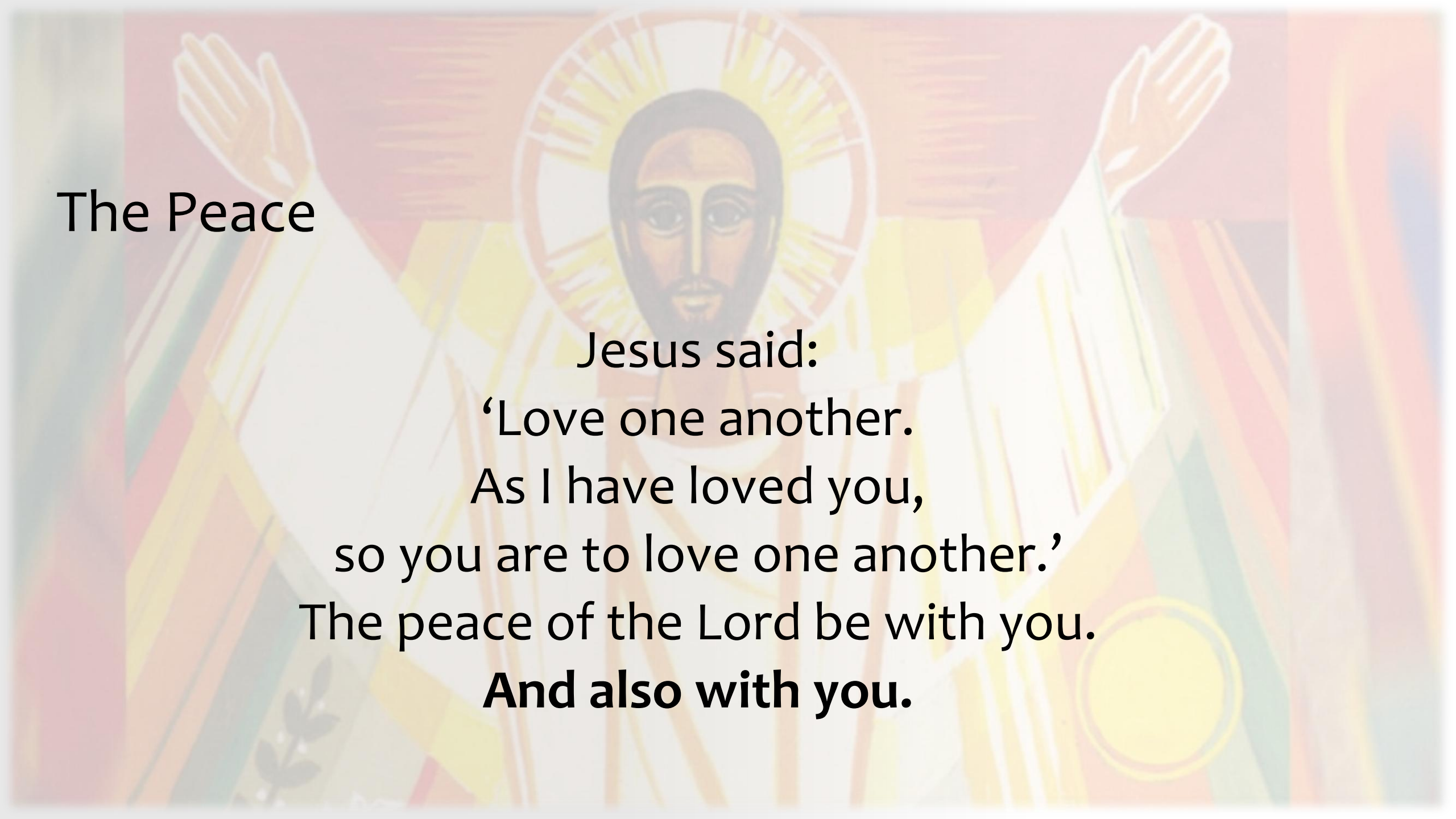
