And thirdly, at 3pm on Saturdays, we shall be taking a short walk from Old Glossop



Church to a place of water. When there, we shall ask for God's blessing on the water, returning to Church for refreshments afterwards.

## Eco Tip of the week

**Cold mornings have officially arrived so you may be thinking about turning on the heating!**

**1. Heat Pumps** - are a great way to heat your home whilst decreasing your carbon footprint. They work by extracting heat from the air or ground which is then used to heat your homes. They still require electricity to run but much less and the fuel is free. Additionally, installing a heat pump can make you eligible for financial support.

**2. Green Gas** - For many, the cost of installing heat pumps may not be feasible. yet green gas tariffs enable you to improve sustainability without having to change your heating system. Green gas is sourced from lower carbon sources such as anaerobic digesters or landfill gas instead of fossil fuel gas.
