Epistle - Philippians 2:1-13

¹ If then there is any encouragement in Christ,
any consolation from love, any sharing in the
Spirit, any compassion and sympathy, ² make my
joy complete: be of the same mind, having the
same love, being in full accord and of one mind.
³ Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but
in humility regard others as better than
yourselves. ⁴ Let each of you look not to your
own interests, but to the interests of others.
⁵ Let the same mind be in you that was in Christ
Jesus, ⁶ who, though he was in the form of God,
did not regard equality with God as something to
be exploited, ⁷ but emptied himself, taking the
form of a slave, being born in human likeness.
And being found in human form,
⁸ he humbled himself and became obedient to the
point of death - even death on a cross.
⁹ Therefore God also highly exalted him
and gave him the name that is above every name,
¹⁰ so that at the name of Jesus every knee should
bend, in heaven and on earth and under the earth,
¹¹ and every tongue should confess
that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the
Father.
¹² Therefore, my beloved, just as you have always
obeyed me, not only in my presence, but much
more now in my absence, work out your own
salvation with fear and trembling; ¹³ for it is God
who is at work in you, enabling you both to will
and to work for his good pleasure.

Gospel - Matthew 21: 23-32

*Hear the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ
according to Matthew.*

All: Glory to you, O Lord.

²³ When he entered the temple, the chief priests and
the elders of the people came to him as he was
teaching, and said, 'By what authority are you doing
these things, and who gave you this authority?'
²⁴ Jesus said to them, 'I will also ask you one
question; if you tell me the answer, then I will also
tell you by what authority I do these things.
²⁵ Did the baptism of John come from heaven, or was
it of human origin?' And they argued with one
another, 'If we say, "From heaven", he will say to us,
"Why then did you not believe him?"' ²⁶ But if we say,
"Of human origin", we are afraid of the crowd; for all
regard John as a prophet.'
²⁷ So they answered Jesus, 'We do not know.' And he
said to them, 'Neither will I tell you by what
authority I am doing these things.
²⁸ 'What do you think? A man had two sons; he went
to the first and said, "Son, go and work in the
vineyard today." ²⁹ He answered, "I will not"; but
later he changed his mind and went. ³⁰ The father
went to the second and said the same; and he
answered, "I go, sir"; but he did not go. ³¹ Which of
the two did the will of his father?' They said, 'The
first.' Jesus said to them, 'Truly I tell you, the tax-
collectors and the prostitutes are going into the
kingdom of God ahead of you. ³² For John came to
you in the way of righteousness and you did not
believe him, but the tax-collectors and the prostitutes
believed him; and even after you saw it, you did not
change your minds and believe him.

Harvest Readings

Epistle - Deuteronomy 8.7–18

⁷ For the Lord your God is bringing you into a good land, a land with flowing streams, with springs and underground waters welling up in valleys and hills, ⁸ a land of wheat and barley, of vines and fig trees and pomegranates, a land of olive trees and honey, ⁹ a land where you may eat bread without scarcity, where you will lack nothing, a land whose stones are iron and from whose hills you may mine copper.

¹⁰ You shall eat your fill and bless the Lord your God for the good land that he has given you.

Take care that you do not forget the Lord your God, by failing to keep his commandments, his ordinances, and his statutes, which I am commanding you today.

¹² When you have eaten your fill and have built fine houses and live in them, ¹³ and when your herds and flocks have multiplied, and your silver and gold is multiplied, and all that you have is multiplied, ¹⁴ then do not exalt yourself, forgetting the Lord your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery, ¹⁵ who led you through the great and terrible wilderness, an arid waste-land with poisonous snakes and scorpions.

He made water flow for you from flint rock, ¹⁶ and fed you in the wilderness with manna that your ancestors did not know, to humble you and to test you, and in the end to do you good.

¹⁷ Do not say to yourself, 'My power and the might of my own hand have gained me this wealth.' ¹⁸ But remember the Lord your God, for it is he who gives you power to get wealth, so that he may confirm his covenant that he swore to your ancestors, as he is doing today.

Epistle - 2 Corinthians 9:6-end

⁶ The point is this: the one who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and the one who sows bountifully will also reap bountifully.

⁷ Each of you must give as you have made up your mind, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.

⁸ And God is able to provide you with every blessing in abundance, so that by always having enough of everything, you may share abundantly in every good work. ⁹ As it is written,

'He scatters abroad, he gives to the poor; his righteousness endures for ever.'

¹⁰ He who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food will supply and multiply your seed for sowing and increase the harvest of your righteousness.

¹¹ You will be enriched in every way for your great generosity, which will produce thanksgiving to God through us; ¹² for the rendering of this ministry not only supplies the needs of the saints but also overflows with many thanksgivings to God.

¹³ Through the testing of this ministry you glorify God by your obedience to the confession of the gospel of Christ and by the generosity of your sharing with them and with all others, ¹⁴ while they long for you and pray for you because of the surpassing grace of God that he has given you. ¹⁵ Thanks be to God for his indescribable gift!

Gospel - Luke 12: 16-30

Hear the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to Luke

All: Glory to you, O Lord.

¹⁶ Then he told them a parable: 'The land of a rich man produced abundantly. ¹⁷ And he thought to himself, "What should I do, for I have no place to store my crops?"' ¹⁸ Then he said, "I will do this: I will pull down my barns and build larger ones, and there I will store all my grain and my goods. ¹⁹ And I will say to my soul, Soul, you have ample goods laid up for many years; relax, eat, drink, be merry."

²⁰ But God said to him, "You fool! This very night your life is being demanded of you. And the things you have prepared, whose will they be?"' ²¹ So it is with those who store up treasures for themselves but are not rich towards God.'

²² He said to his disciples, 'Therefore I tell you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat, or about your body, what you will wear. ²³ For life is more than food, and the body more than clothing.

²⁴ Consider the ravens: they neither sow nor reap, they have neither storehouse nor barn, and yet God feeds them. Of how much more value are you than the birds!

²⁵ And can any of you by worrying add a single hour to your span of life? ²⁶ If then you are not able to do so small a thing as that, why do you worry about the rest?

²⁷ Consider the lilies, how they grow: they neither toil nor spin; yet I tell you, even Solomon in all his glory was not clothed like one of these. ²⁸ But if God so clothes the grass of the field, which is alive today and tomorrow is thrown into the oven, how much more will he clothe you—you of little faith! ²⁹ And do not keep striving for what you are to eat and what you are to drink, and do not keep worrying. ³⁰ For it is the nations of the world that strive after all these things, and your Father knows that you need them.
