We will have tea and coffee on arrival.

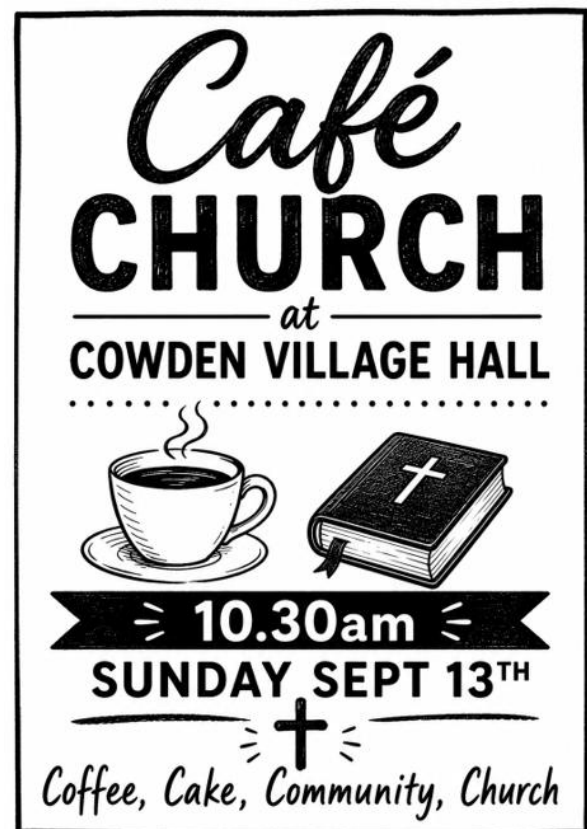
The evening will start with a short bible thought and a time of sung worship. The evening will then continue with several slots praying in small groups on various topics covering the life of our church and communities.

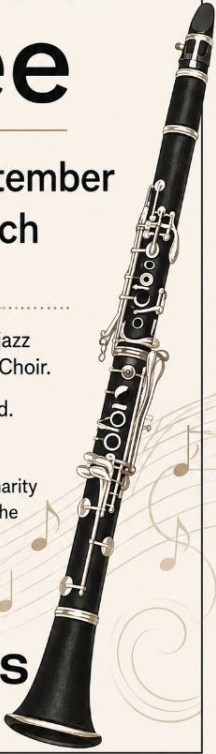
