Works at Treslothan Church

Re-roofing and re-pointing of Treslothan church will begin in September; you will all appreciate these works are very weather dependant, but below are our intended dates:

- The enabling works and erection of the scaffold will start around the 2nd of September and these works will last at least a week.
- From the 16th September the roofing works can start - this is a condition of our bat license.
- The re-pointing works will take place from the mid to end of September.
- The roofing works will take longer but the intention is to have them finished by the second week of December so Christmas events can take place as normal.

The intention is for the Church to be available for use on Sunday. Becky will update if there are changes of venue for Wild Mondays so make sure she has your contact details.

You will also notice some works taking place in the churchyard. Thanks to the People's Postcode Lottery Grassroots grant from Groundworks and a further grant from the National Grid we have been awarded £6k to clear invasive species and increase biodiversity. These works have begun and will take place alongside the roofing and re-pointing.

The weather will play such a big part in the programme of works, so thank you in advance for your patience and we will keep you updated on our progress. Despite the long dry summer, please pray for a few more dry days in September so that the roofers can do their work. We also give thanks to God for the grants that have enabled this urgent work to go ahead.

So a BIG thank you to all of our funders who have now awarded us just over £300k
