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Eco Tip of the week

Autumn is the perfect time to construct wildlife friendly features in your garden!

1. Bird boxes - Bird populations are struggling, largely due to habitat loss. Birds such as Swifts, House Sparrows and Starlings rely on houses for nests yet our houses are becoming less and less bird friendly. A simple way to help is to put up some bird nesting boxes in your garden.

2. Garden Pond - Ponds are great for a range of wildlife, supporting newts, frogs, birds and insects, yet 70% of ponds in the UK have disappeared making garden ponds even more vital to support biodiversity. A pond can be a beautiful feature in your garden and will add diversity to the types of plants and animals for you to enjoy. If you need to top up your pond, try to use harvested rain water.
