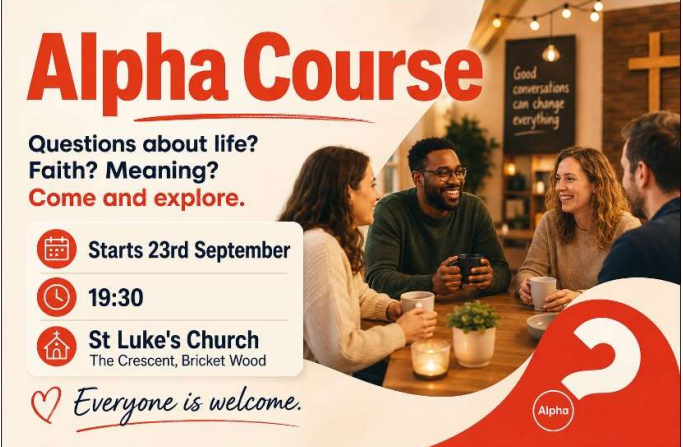
NOTICES
