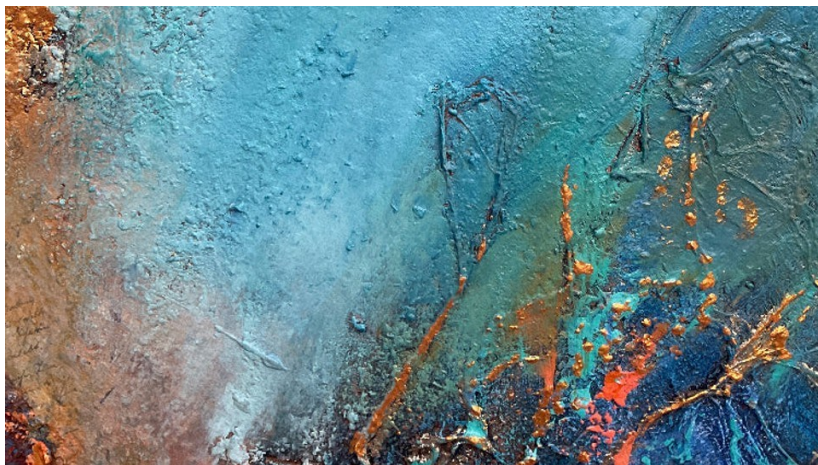

Who are you praying for, and inviting to come along this time?

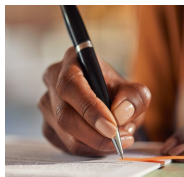
Sessions last around 90 minutes and are completely free. Across the weeks you'll have the chance to discover more about God, Jesus, and the journey of life.
