Priest As we join together in Spiritual Communion with all those celebrating the Holy Eucharist today Lord, we say:

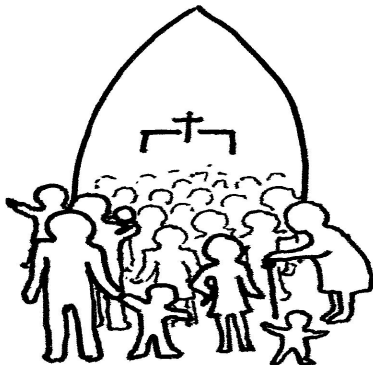
All **Lord, you stand at the door of our hearts and knock.**
