**From the rector.....**The last year has been particularly challenging in all sorts of ways, church life being just one!

However, it has had some positives; the continuous merry-go-round of the service rota (which I knew in my heart needed to change but did not have the wherewithal to do so) had to stop due to the restrictions. Our bishops encouraged us to think before we went back to doing the same thing as before. They encouraged us to be more intentionally missional, to be more outward looking, work with other partners in our communities, and find other ways of working so that there is time to develop contacts and relationships with people outside our churches.

Jesus told us, *Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptising them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you.* (Matthew 28:19,20) And we do try in some small ways, but, if we are honest with ourselves, it is much nicer to stick together in our churches, enjoying the fellowship and worship with people we have come to know - it feels safe and comfortable. However, God calls us to share the Good News of his love and plan for our lives with those who do not know his love yet.

With all that in mind, we are going to have a meeting for the whole church on 26<sup>th</sup> May 7pm, to share a possible way ahead for our benefice and parishes. As this is after 17<sup>th</sup> May, it will be possible for 2 households to meet indoors, which means if you don't do Zoom you might be able to sit in someone else's house for the meeting. We will, of course, take notes so that we can let as many people know as possible. I feel excited about the future and believe the time is right for us to again make a real difference in our parishes, working alongside God, his family, and others. Everyone is needed and everyone has a part to play - we particularly need people to pray.
