Angela's Barbeque

The week commencing August 9th was memorable for Gedney/Sutton St James band of ringers as we staged a two tower outing on Tuesday evening followed by the above barbeque on Saturday evening, August 14th. Tuesday was a repeat of "Sojourns of a Summer Evening", some five years ago when we rang at Newton –in-the –Isle followed by Tydd St Giles, heavy rain as we exited our cars, running for the comfort of the Crown and Mitre, named after one Nicholas Breakspeare, a once curate of this parish who became the only Englishman to occupy the papal throne as Pope Adrian 1V. Luckily on this occasion the weather treated us kindly, overcast but pleasantly warm and still.

The detached tower at Tydd St Giles is relatively modern, dating from the 1880's as the earlier one, part of the church building collapsed in 1741, taking some of the church with it, local lore informing us that the Devil pushed it over as he didn't like the sound of its bells. Well, I cannot say the current lot are particularly tuneful, and with the considerable movement of the tower, are not particularly easy to ring. But, readers, this is an oddity which adds to the interest ringers find in visiting towers other than their own.

At Angela's request I organised, prior to the Saturday barbeque some afternoon ringing at Leverington and Wisbech St Mary. Readers may recall the story of the Leverington widow, who many years ago was baking cakes and on removing them from her oven was confronted by the Devil at her cottage door. Encircled by a whirlwind he carried her off over Leverington spire never to be seen again. As Reverend Sandra Gardner remarked, "The Devil was once active in these parts" I should also mention ringing for a wedding at Gedney Hill, a late request from Rev. Mike Ongyeth thereby hopefully adding to the joy of the happy couple and their guests.

Ringling finished we made our way to Walnut Tree Farm and the lovely garden surrounding the home of our host and hostess, Will and Angela. A fire pit blazing, the tantalising aroma of sausages, burgers and chicken grilled by Will over the charcoal, wine, the company-ah what a delightful evenings culmination of our afternoons outing. On behalf of our band I thank Will and Angela for their warm hospitality and our contacts who met us and gained access to the towers.

In conclusion a sad note re Newton which we were told is scheduled for closure, another church gone for all time. For 35 years I was an expatriate, 17 of these in Arab countries where they support their mosques. If only we supported our churches.

A Time to Change Together (TTCT) Resourcing Sustainable Church

The vision of the Diocese of Lincoln is to serve all God's people, sharing with them the transforming love of God. We've committed to become a diocese that is healthy, vibrant and sustainable. This means that we will be faithful in our worship, confident in our discipleship and joyful in our service. It also means that we will have the courage to change when we believe that God is calling us to do so.

In chapter 3 of Ecclesiastes, the writer tells us: 'For everything there is a season, and a time for every matter under heaven... a time to tear and a time to sew; a time to keep silence, and a time to speak.'

Together, we need to discern what God is calling us to, both now and in the future. We need to renew, refocus, and reimagine, as we seek God's purpose for His people and His creation. We need to join in with God's work, and the missionary activity of the Holy Spirit.

The local church and its growth, in all its different forms and varieties, must be at the heart of everything we are. Not all churches have to be the same or try to do the same things, but we need to work together to serve our communities. Conversations of discernment will be led by the incumbent or by delegated officers such as churchwardens to reflect upon the unique role of each church.

Churches, benefices, deaneries and groupings of deaneries will discuss how to build patterns of working together in Local Mission Partnerships. This process will be supported by bishops, archdeacons, rural deans, lay chairs and the Parish Support Offices in Lincoln

Parishes and benefices will meet with the newly trained Covenant Pastors, who will assist each parish to agree a financial pledge to the diocese for the support of ministry. These covenant conversations about parish share will be phased meetings in order to ensure that the whole diocese is covered during the course of the year. These meetings are part of our generous giving response to God's generosity to us.

Every ordained and lay minister who holds the bishop's licence will be invited to a vocational conversation, which will be an opportunity to reflect on her/his ministry, and will parallel the reflective conversations that will be going on in church congregations. The intention of these conversations is to listen, to support and to discern ways forward, for individuals and for the diocesan family of ministers as a whole.

Together, through consultation and agreement, we have discerned that now is the time to act; now is the Time to Change Together.



Micki gave us a brief history of her lifelong interest and involvement with children's work within the Church of England.
- It is hoped to once again develop the strong links that had been fostered with Fleetwood Lane Primary School, pre pandemic, and we look forward to planning for and welcoming children and staff for various services in the next few months.
- **ADVENT FAYRE** is being planned for Saturday, 11th and Sunday 12th December in the church. It is also hoped to have our annual Carol Service at the end of the event. Please put these dates in your diary and further details will follow each month.
- We are delighted that the numbers attending the 9.00 a.m. service on the first Sunday of each month are increasing and we welcome members of other churches in our Deanery to that service. People wishing to attend a Eucharistic Service on other Sundays may like to visit Gedney on the second and fourth Sundays of the month at 11.00 a.m., or All Saints, Holbeach has a Eucharistic service every Sunday at 10.30 a.m., except on the first Sunday of the month.






