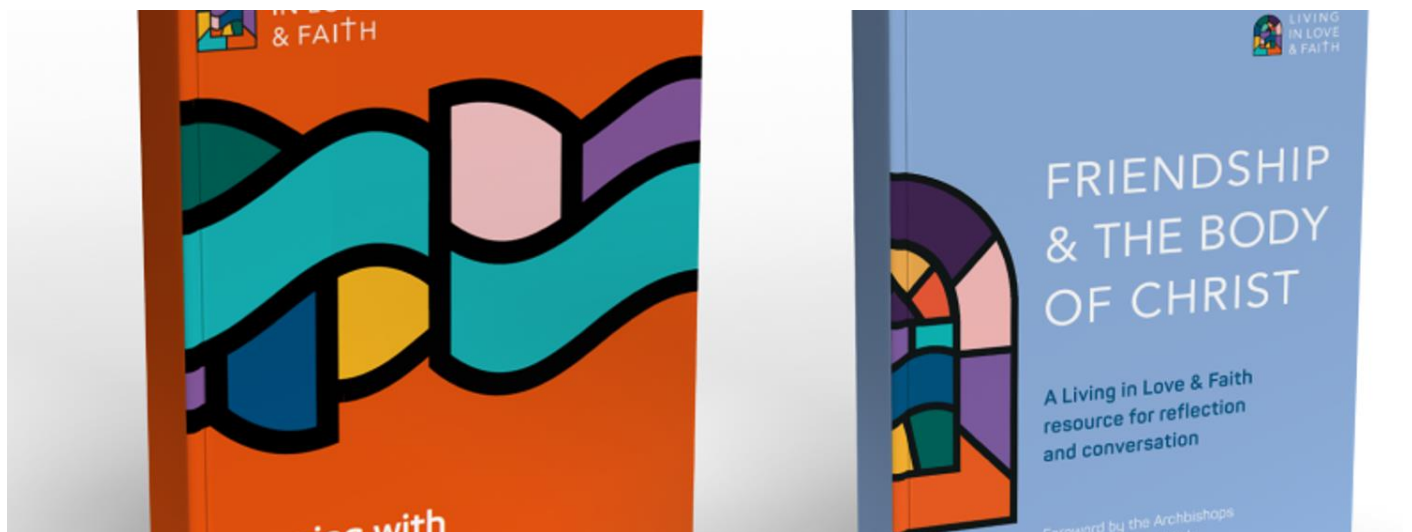


Scampton are National Church Tourism Awards Finalists!

Listening in Love and Faith Report

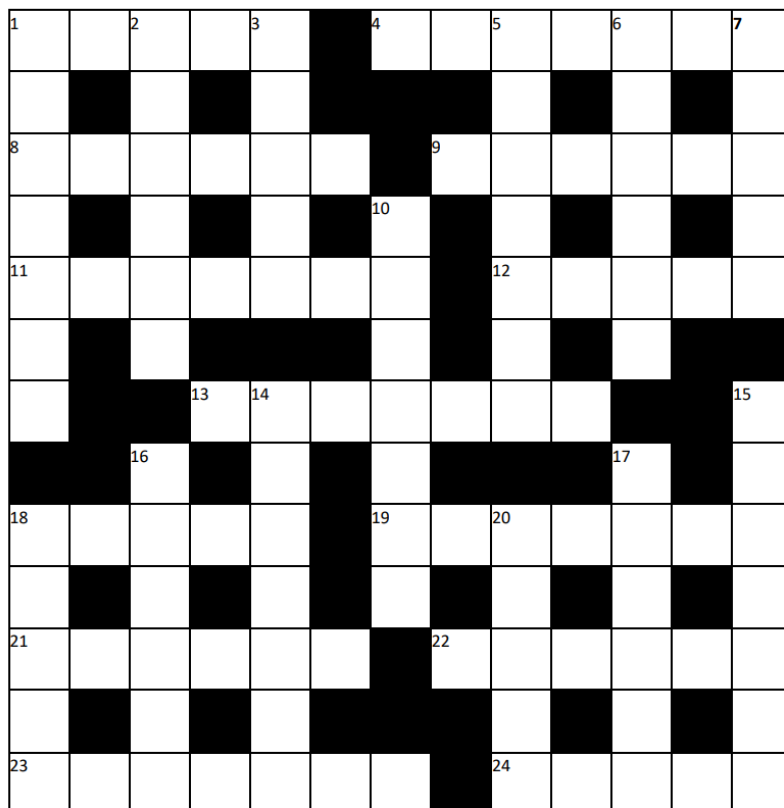
