YOUR GENEROSITY

The regular weekly attendance is 157 adults (according to recent three-year averages). The challenge in 2023 is an anticipated cost increase of a further £8,000.

Income during 2022 totalled £104K from:

- Standing orders £55K
- Cash collections during worship services £9K
- Gift aid recovery £11K
- Life events funerals, weddings, baptisms £9K
- Plus other sources.

Costs in 2022 were £100K including:

- General repairs & building upkeep £6K
- Utilities £5K
- Parish share cost of ministry £65K
- Expenses such as insurance, village hall hire, photocopier, garden maintenance and more

Giving to God's work through the church should be a priority. Is it time to increase?
