Winchester Basics Bank: during July we make our donations to the Basics Bank, instead of at harvest time, as requested, so that their supplies are evened out through the year. Demand for their services in Winchester and the surrounding area continues to increase:

- In 2024 they served 8562 people and the number is expected to be even higher in 2025. They will also provide 500 meals over the summer holidays for children who normally have free school meals.
- Every week WBB has to spend money to top up supplies. In 2023 they spent £944 per week; in 2024 they spent £1470 p.w. and the forecast for 2025 is that the spend will exceed £2000 per week.

WBB is always short of tinned veg and fruits, tinned meat, spaghetti bolognese and pasta, but the most practical way to support them is to donate money, either online at <u>https://winchesterbasicsbank.co.uk/</u> or by Gift Aid envelopes (cash, or cheques payable to Winchester Basics Bank). During July Gift Aid envelopes are available in the churches.

St Bartholomew's Refurbishment: we are delighted to have at last received the final permission to proceed! A contractor is being appointed, and details of the timetable and impact will be made available as soon as we know them.
