## A Message from Fr Paul

We often think of August as a sun and fun month, that time when we disappear off on our holidays, a time when we can relax and take it just a little bit easy. We often think this way in church as well, however this is not the case, even though we may be taking it easy there are plenty of feast days and saints days to keep us busy. With the feast of the transfiguration of the Lord on the 6th August and the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary on the 15th. With these two great feast days there is a whole multitude of saints days from St Augustine to the Passion of St John the Baptist, from St Clare to St Maximilian Mary Kolbe. While we are taking things just a little bit easy this month, it would be a good opportunity to have a quick look at some of these of these saints, for their lives are far from boring.

Saint Augustine made an amazing journey in his life time, he was once a pagan priest and a very important one, his mother St Monica prayed earnestly for his conversion to Christianity. Finding that the pagan life he was living to be very shallow, lacking in spirituality and answers, he converted to Christianity and became to bishop of Hippo in North Africa. St Clare worked alongside St Francis of Assisi, she started the equivalent order of nuns Called the Poor Clares to work alongside Franciscan monks. Like the monks, the order of Poor Clares took a vow of complete poverty having nothing to their name, unlike the monks they were completely enclosed and rarely came out of their convent, reliant on the charity of other. St Maximilian Kolbe was a real wartime hero; a priest from Poland who resisted the Nazi, helping Jewish people escape their grip. He would print pamphlets and have them distributed, along with hiding Jewish people, which led him to being imprisoned himself. St Maximilian gave his own life so that one of the other inmates, who had a family, could have his. The man he saved was present at St Maximillian's Canonisation.

Take time this month to have a look at one of these, or look at another saint, all of whom were ordinary people who did amazing things.




