Message from Rob Soames, Childrey

Christianity's message of forgiveness often seems to be forgotten nowadays. Guy de Keramel, Archbishop of Toulouse, recently wrote: Forgiveness is the way to construct peace, through a love which conquers evil.

Forgiveness doesn't dispense justice; but it is an unavoidable condition of peace. Forgiving love is the essential foundation for peace - as Christ proved to us when giving his life for us.

Forgiveness pays back all debts. It pardons and comes to help those who are facing evil of all kinds. It re-establishes relationships. Justice recognises legal wrongs and seeks to repair injustices, but that is all it can do. Forgiveness is needed to reconcile people, communities or countries, re-establishing relationships of confidence and respectful friendship.

Without reconciliation, peace is illusory. History shows there cannot be peace between two countries at war just by signing a treaty which humiliates the vanquished; in time the hour for revenge comes. But if we take time to meet the 'other', to understand, to discover what is good in them so as to pardon and arrive at peace.... this road is long. It may seem impossible, in human terms, to

pardon. But the human heart, by the grace of God, can find in itself an unimaginable strength to pardon. The way of reconciliation ends up with the two parties learning to walk together in the same direction.
