

Rest

We live in a world which rarely seems to stop, or even pause – seeking the fastest internet speed, fast food and instant messaging. August for some gives an opportunity for a change of pace as schools close and holidays may be taken. But we all need times of rest and refreshment. As someone once wisely said: "We need to remember we are human beings, not human doings." Following the Biblical creation account in Genesis God rested. This gift of rest is woven into creation. God created rhythms, an ebb and flow, a time to reap and sow and a time to leave fallow. Fallow times are not a waste of time but time which gifts renewal and restoration.

Rest looks different for everyone – for some it's reading a novel, for others it's walking, sewing, watching sport, drawing, digging in the garden, talking with friends, or simply an afternoon nap. We need rest for our bodies, minds and souls. It's about remembering we are not machines or robots, but wonderful human beings created to breathe in and breathe out, to wonder and celebrate the gifts which are all around us – a reminder that God is always with us.

Imagine what our communities would be like if we truly made space for rest. More time to listen deeply to one another, to notice the beauty of creation; space for people to 'be' without always having to do. We can offer rest to others by being gentle, undemanding, showing grace instead of adding pressure. So, as we journey through this summer let's not feel guilty about resting, but receive it as a glorious gift – remembering Jesus' words in Matthew 11:28:

'Come to me all who are weary and heavy-laden and you will find rest for your souls'
