

From Rev'd Tom Benson

Dear friends,

Welcome to September. This is very often a really busy time of year as we return to school, gather the final crops in and prepare for darker evenings, frosts and sweeping up endless leaves. September traditionally feels to me more like the start of the new year than January. It is of course a time of new beginnings with the start of the school year, and a time when activities and events resume after the summer break.

"All good gifts around us are sent from heaven above". Do you recognise these words? They are from the Harvest hymn, 'We plough the fields and scatter'. Our Harvest Thanksgiving Services begin in September and you are all most welcome - you don't have to be a farmer or one of our regular worshippers to join in with the celebrations. Time to Celebrate!

Open the Book (OtB) is an exciting story-telling project where Bible stories are shared with children in a way that is fun, interactive and memorable. 






Notes from Farley Chamberlayne

The Basics Banks, which Awbridge church supports, are run by Southampton City Mission. The food is distributed by volunteers, at food banks run by church communities in Southampton, for those referred to them by official agencies: Please see the list below which prioritises the items most needed. https://southamptoncitymission.co.uk/get-involved/how-to-donate#shopping-list

Currently they are really short of tinned meats (hot), small jars of coffee, sugar (small bags), rice, noodles (pkts), custard, jams & spreads, UHT milk and tins of veg, fruit, tomatoes, fish, rice pudding & macaroni cheese, also nappies (sizes 4,5&6+) and toiletries. Smaller packets of most items are best for re-distribution.

magazine, but most of all a YouTuber, exploring English country churches and sharing their stories online."


