



CITIZENS ADVICE



My son and I are both struggling to find work at the moment. He's just finished university and looking for his first job, and I'm retired but need to top up my income. We've both been sending out applications for a while now, could unpaid work help us find something?

Whether you're trying to get into work for the first time or after time off, finding a job can be really challenging. It's always a good idea to think about what skills or experience you could be missing for the kind of work you want, especially when feeling stuck after weeks or months of sending out job applications.

If you can afford to take unpaid work, it can be a good way to plug gaps in your CV and get a taste for different types of jobs. These sorts of roles usually come in the form of volunteering, work experience, or internships.

If you receive welfare benefits, you should check the Citizens Advice website or speak to an adviser before taking unpaid work. And because the rules around unpaid internships are complicated, you should get advice on being paid less than the minimum wage before applying to this type of role.

Volunteer roles are often well-defined and can expose you to specific types of work, whether you're looking for experience in an office or something more practical, like supporting people in your local community. Charities, including Citizens Advice, usually have a range of opportunities available.

Being a volunteer doesn't just give you a chance to learn and improve skills that are transferable to paid work, it can also help you gain confidence and self-esteem in a professional setting and provide structure to your day or week.

This can set you up well for job applications and interviews by showing employers you've got transferable skills, relevant experience, and are ready to enter paid work. Just like any job advert, you can find plenty of volunteering opportunities online, so it's well worth seeing what's out there if you're interested.

NOTES FROM THE GARDEN

Well when writing this before about June/July, I did not expect June to be so dry and hot. Plants and seeds really struggled to grow and to get established. My onions and shallots, roots failed to get into this dry soil, although now growing, 10% of the crop has died, and the rest are a lot smaller in size than it should be. Rainfall was very low and gardeners have had to water a lot more just to keep plants alive. This is showing that we gardeners will have to adapt our gardening practises. Things such as putting in more water retaining compost and manure in our pots, baskets and in the garden. To help with water retention add some more water tolerant plants.

At our allotment the polytunnel is up and running. It was hard and hot work digging, and then filling the beds with homemade compost. I am now amazed at how much difference a controlled protective micro-climate can make. My wife grew a lot of tomatoes, courgettes, cucumbers and peppers at home. Now we have planted them in the tunnel and they are growing strong and flowering, all within a few weeks. I am constantly tying them up, and with the tomatoes I am nipping out a lot of side shoots daily.

Outside of the tunnel the allotment plants have been struggling, potatoes look good but are in need of a good soaking from some rain. Sweetcorn, leeks and newly planted greens are established but need constant watering.

August it is time to harvest, dig up potatoes, dry onions and shallots so they can be stored. Keep picking beans, and harvest beetroot. Courgettes will need picking when ready to keep them producing more fruit, otherwise the plants will think they have done their job and stop.

In September it is time to start tiding up in the garden - I compost plants that have finished. Pull up cane supports used for climbing beans etc, use a large plastic flower pot with the bottom cut out, and attach to the side of the shed or the compost bin which can be used to store upright canes for the winter. Collect seed from your favourite plants before you get rid of them and store in paper envelopes with a label. Wash greenhouse glass and repair if necessary. Keep deadheading flowers and feed once a week to encourage growth as the daylight shortens.

August is considered to be the start of autumn, and is of course the Walsham Le Willows open gardens weekend on the bank holiday Sunday and Monday. The money raised will go to good causes and the village charity's benefit also. We will be opening our garden to you all, we hope to see you and share gardens notes LIVE.

UK CARE SECTOR

Question – I have read that most hospitals have a PALS office, but what exactly do they do?

Answer – PALS, stands for Patient Advice and Liaison Service. It is an English NHS Service which provides and offers confidential advice, support and information on health-related matters. It is a point of contact for patients, their relatives and carers. They also are there if a person has any concerns about the service being received in hospital, have a complaint, or would like to give a compliment about service received. Usually the PALS team have an appointment system and appointments can be booked by ringing your local hospital.

Question – I am a Blue Badge holder, do I have to pay toll charges on UK roads, such as if I go through the Dartford Tunnel?

Answer – If you hold a Blue Badge you may be exempt from some toll charges. Visit the website below where you can read where the exemptions are including details in regards to the London Congestion Charge. www.bluebadgecompany.co.uk

Question – I hear and read almost daily about a new scam, and I do not know if the information itself is a scam or they are a genuine notification. Is there somewhere I can visit online for authentic notifications?

Answer – Which the consumer organisation has a **Scam Alerts free service** which you can trust. It is designed to help people stay informed about the latest scams and avoid falling victim to fraud. Visit - www.which.co.uk and sign up for the scam alert emails. The website also has other information such as how to spot potential scams, different types, etc.

Question – Are continence products for personal use free of VAT in the UK?

Answer - Yes, continence products for personal use can be VAT-exempt in the UK for individuals who are disabled or have a long-term illness. This means that eligible individuals can purchase these products without paying the standard 20% VAT. However, it is not easy to see where this is mentioned on some online websites where many people now purchase them. It is also worth asking other retailers, such as chemists and supermarkets, if they are marked as VAT free and if not, can you have the reduction as they are for personal use.






