Saint Dominic

1170—1221

Saint Dominic was born in Spain and spent much of his life in France before living in Italy where he is enshrined at the heart of the Dominicans—Bologna. It was after a vision in 1208 of Our Lady who gave him a Rosary that in 1215 he and six others founded the Order. The distinctive white habit of the Dominicans is a common sight in the City of Rome and many pilgrims visit the Church of S Sabina and the Angelicum. Canonised in 1234 fondly nick-named “The Hound of the Lord” is of special attraction to me!
