Pio of Pietrelcina,
1887—1968

Fondly known as Padre Pio, this very contemporary saint was a renowned Confessor and at a time when we are fighting to protect the seal of the Sacrament of Reconciliation we could all seek the help of his prayers. Brought up to attend Daily Mass at an early age, he dedicated his life to God and later entered the Capuchin Order and donned the Franciscan

Habit, it is not without understanding as his baptismal name was Francesco. After several times of severe illness and rehearsing several heavenly visions, as did his patron, in 1918 Padre received the Stigmata. He was Beatified in 1999 and Canonized three years later.
