SERVICE OF REFLECTION FOR THOSE AFFECTED BY SUICIDE

An opportunity for all those affected by suicide to come together in a safe and supportive space to remember those they have lost. All are welcome - of all faiths or none - to this special event.

Held on the closest weekend to World Suicide
Prevention Day, under the shared umbrella of "Time
Together" with a similar service held on the same
weekend at St Martin-in-the-Fields in London,
Manchester Cathedral and in Leicester, in
recognition and support of a wider community of
those who are bereaved.

The Celtic Male Ensemble will provide choral music, with a performance by the Singing for Wellbeing group for those bereaved by suicide. Refreshments afterwards in the Chapter House where there will be an opportunity to meet with those who offer support services in the community.

This service is a collaboration between Truro Cathedral, Cornwall's Suicide Liaison Service, and all agencies in Cornwall that work towards preventing suicide and offer support to those who are left behind.
