

#### From Rev'd Tom Benson

Dear friends.

I would like to start with a big thank you to everyone who supported the Classic and Custom show in Braishfield on the 4<sup>th</sup> of October, as part of our developing mission with the biking community. It brought together bikes and bikers of all ages and was supported by three Christian biker organisations - The Knights of Antioch, The Christian Motorcycle Association and the 59 Club. Despite the weather, we reckon that there were over 100 bikes that attended the afternoon and lots of people on foot and travelling by car. We raised over £750 for the Hampshire Air Ambulance. We are planning to hold a Bikers Carol service at King's Somborne to which everyone is welcome and will release the date soon.


