### Cover Picture

Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque 1647—1690

A French nun as a child she suffered poor health and her

father died prematurely. During a four year battle she had vowed to become a religious while being educated at a Carmelite School but this was not allowed by her family whom she had to support. Eventually in 1671 she entered the Visitation Convent at Paray-le-Monial where she

remained until her death: here she received visions of The Sacred Heart of Our Lord . As a result such devotions as the First Friday and indeed the solemnity itself continues in the Church of today.
