# **Adventures in Prayer**

It is a delight to be part of the group that is meeting at The Old School House in Northborough to consider prayer.

The sessions start with a short video discussing various aspects of prayer, using the Lord's Prayer as a starting point.

What has become more and more evident in the ensuing conversations is how different our own individual prayer lives are.

Wonder at the glories of creation, the peace of a quiet church, the difficulties of loved ones, the suffering in many parts of the world – all these and more spur us into prayer.

Music, poetry, art, the Bible itself, provide open doorways to a God who listens, a God who cares, a God who delights in us and absolutely loves it when we delight in him.

They help us to focus on the depth and height of God's love for us and call out in us a response to love him with our whole being.

Prayer is the adventure of a lifetime, sometimes difficult, sometimes so joyful we feel as though we could indeed burst with joy, and, in the end, we don't need elaborate words, or fancy structures. As the first session on Prayer said – Keep it simple, keep it real, keep it up!

Wherever you are on your life journey we hope you will find something useful there.


Their aim is to showcase some of the amazing work done in our city and provide resources that will help improve the Peterborough community.
