Mini Knit Christmas Stockings



Supplies: UK Size 4 mm Scraps of any colour Double Knitting Yarn (About 12 yards are needed) Finished Stocking Size: Approximately 4-5"

Instructions for Basic Stocking with Contrasting Colour Cuff

(CC = Contrasting Colour, MC = Main Colour)

Using CC, Cast on 24 stitches

Cuff:

Row 1: Knit

Row 2: Purl

Row 3: Knit

Row 4: Purl

Row 5: Knit

Cut CC yarn and attach MC yarn



Body of Stocking:

With MC and beginning with a Knit row, work 16 rows in stocking stitch (Knit one row, purl one row)

Make Heel Using Short Rows:

Knit 13 – Turn

Purl 3 – Turn

Knit 4 – Turn

Purl 5 - Turn

Knit 6 - Turn

Purl 7 – Turn

Knit 8 – Turn

Purl 9 – Turn

Knit 10 – Turn

Purl to end of row

Toe of Stocking:

Beginning with a Knit row, work 8 rows in stocking stitch

Next row: K2 tog, K1 across row (16 stitches)

Next row: Purl

Next row: K2 tog across row (8 stitches)

Cut yarn leaving a long tail and thread this yam through the remaining stitches, pulling tightly to gather. Sew seam with wrong sides together, turn right side out, add loop to back of stocking (approx. 4") and decorate as you choose.
