Welcome to our monthly newsletter, which we hope will keep you informed of what's happening in our parish life, the community and also more widely.

Well I went off on holiday to South Africa in summer weather and came back to Autumn and rather cool weather, though it is lovely to see how the grass and gardens have recovered from the very dry summer we had. This is a time of year to particularly focus on Creation, as the wider church holds its annual 'Creationtide' season. Creationtide, also known as the 'Season of Creation', is an annual period from 1st September to 4th October, observed by Christians to celebrate God as the Creator of the universe and to encourage care for the environment. It is a time for churches and communities to focus on nature, engage in worship and prayer, reflect on their relationship with God's creation, and take action to protect the planet.

At St Mary's we have been involved in all of the above! We held our Harvest Festival this last weekend (28th September) as we celebrated God's provision, thought of the whole food chain and the many involved in food production from seed to table and everyone involved in between. How wonderful to see the church looking so beautiful and to see the generosity of our congregation as they brought foodstuffs to be donated to West Berks Foodbank.



Another important event taking place in this same period of time (22nd September –5th October) is 'Fairtrade Fortnight' where we are encouraged this year to 'Do it Fair'. Fairtrade is about fairer pay and fairer work conditions and we encourage others to join us in being more aware of products we can buy instead, which bear the Fairtrade logo.


