

St Bartholomew's Refurbishment: We anticipate that the work will begin on 20<sup>th</sup> October, so Little Wrigglers will meet on 8<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> October and then pause until the spring. Choral Evensong with the Alleyn Singers: all are welcome to this special service on Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> October at 5pm at St Lawrence, offered by the choir as a warm-up for their performance at Romsey Abbey on the Sunday.

**Autumn Study Groups:** we will be exploring the Nicene Creed, as this year marks the 1700th anniversary of the Creed, first formulated at the Council of Nicaea in 325 AD. Christians around the world are celebrating its enduring significance, as it not only shapes our theology but also unites us in faith across traditions. To guide our reflections, we will be using the Church of England's *We Believe* booklet, which offers 24 daily readings that we will unpack together in our weekly groups. The 5-week course will begin w/c 3rd November and sign-up forms are available in the churches, for return **by 12**<sup>th</sup> **October**.

St Lawrence temporary closure: please note that the church will be closed from Monday 13<sup>th</sup> to Friday 17<sup>th</sup> October, while scaffolding is in place and work is carried out to replace the leaking rooflight. Hyde900 events planned for the weekend include a concert by Cambridge Renaissance Voices (Friday 24<sup>th</sup> at 7.15pm), AGM (Saturday at 11am) and a lecture on the 'real' Magna Carta, marking the 800<sup>th</sup> anniversary of its final version (Saturday at 7pm).
