- Set up your tree on Wed 26 Nov 6.00 8.00 pm or Thurs 27 Nov 6.00 8.00 pm.
- During set up times, a steward will be on hand to show you where to place your tree.
- Remove your tree after the short service on Sun 30 Nov at 7.00 8.00 pm (or contact Jane to arrange alternative).
- The church will be open to visitors on Saturday 29 Nov 10.00 am 5.00 pm and Sunday 30 Nov 11.00 am 5.00 pm.
- All entries must have a fun, novel or interesting theme, and comply with the sizes specified on the entry form.
- Trees/wreaths can be real, artificial or invented, decorated traditionally, or with a fun, novel or interesting theme.
- All trees for the festival must be illuminated.
- Trees must be supplied with decorations, pot or stand, and its own set of battery-powered lights.
- No entries with electric (plug-in) lights will be accepted.
- Leave enough spare batteries to cover the two days, and spare bulbs if applicable, in a clearly labelled envelope, which should be next to your tree.
- Please place the light switches in a visible place at the base of the tree.
- No naked flames.
- Wreaths must have a wire for hanging.
- If you have any special instructions regarding your tree or operation of lights, please let us know on the entry form.
- There is No on-site parking at All Saints' Church, CB25 9FD.
- Please park at Landbeach Village Hall carpark.
- Bring helpers or a trolley to carry your tree and decorations from the carpark to All Saints'. (Although you can park in the streets nearby, Green End Road can be dangerous to cross at this point to access the Church.)
- Please do not stop on the road outside the church or block our neighbours' drives!
