

# Downton Cuckoo Fair – Autumn Update 2025!

The largest free, not-for-profit event in Wiltshire, helping local community organisations including schools, churches, clubs, and charities raise vital funds to support their activities.

The May 2025 Downton Cuckoo Fair was an extremely successful event again this year with around 17,000 visitors enjoying the wide variety of products, refreshments, activities, and entertainments on offer.

We believe the many local community groups/enterprises taking part benefitted well again from the event and the Cuckoo Fair Team are keen to receive the percentage of total annual income made this year for each one. The Friends of Hale Primary School raised an amazing £2,152 on the day.

Like previous Fairs, this fair saw increased costs which this year came to approximately £43k. The increased costs were partially offset by the generous sponsorship received

from local business Toomers Ltd, together with Batt Broadbent Solicitors who kindly sponsored the Day Leaflet production. We'll be looking for more sponsors next year.

The success of the Fair was largely due to the recruitment of a sufficient number of volunteers to help organise, build and run the event, without whom the fair could not happen. Our sincere thanks are extended to all involved, particularly our new recruits and our sponsors.

The Cuckoo Fair Team will be hosting a number of 'Stakeholder Sessions' this year where anyone - businesses, residents, or local organisations can come along and ask questions or make suggestions. Schools are back, unfortunately along with the wind and rain!

 Here at Downton Parish Council, we've been busy getting 'Winter ready':



- throughout the year, we've proactively kept our drains and gullies clear using Wiltshire Council's Discretionary Gully Clearance Service. We should currently be experiencing the benefit of doing so, however, if you spot any drains or gullies which need further clearance, do get in touch.
- we've checked our stocks of salt, gel sacs, and flood signs and placed an order for additional supplies under the Wiltshire Council Parish Emergency Assistance Scheme.
- Downton's Flood Wardens will be attending 'Lunch & Learn' online Flood Warden Courses during Sept and Oct

- Thanks to all those who got in touch about the woefully inadequate 'Road Closure' yellow signage which appeared on The Borough at the beginning of September. After holding firm discussions with the utility companies and working with the Wiltshire Council Highways Team who grant their permits, Downton Parish Council was able to establish the facts and a sensible way forward. Downton Parish Council proposes to continue to proactively monitor planned roadworks using the 'one.network' online platform and share details with you through the Council's and Community's social media pages.
- We're delighted to announce that the proposed enhancements to the informal pedestrian crossing outside of the Wooden Spoon has been approved by Wiltshire Council's Area Board. We'll keep you posted on timescales.
- Your Councillors and Officers work hard for the betterment of the Parish:



#### **Redlynch and District Local History Society**

Our start to this year's season of talks was "The man in the picture" by Robert Inns. The title refereed to a particular picture displayed in his house, as they were in virtually every house after the War, as he was growing up. The fondly remembered man was his mother's brother in RAF uniform; Robert described his efforts and what he discovered over the past 70 years and noted he <u>still</u> found new information in the course of preparing this talk.

Particularly useful were his mother's address book which gave all the stations and units he was posted to. Photos were worth scrutinising for information, the smallest photos were most useful as they were often the originals posted home with annotations on the back. An enquiry to the Air Historical Branch of the RAF gave a summary of his uncle's loss including the serial number of the aircraft.

In the years up to the 1990s, books were and still are the most useful for in depth RAF operations, units and aircraft details However the internet does now have increasing amounts of information including "RAF Command". This gives aircraft records which tell you the unit to which a particular aircraft was on charge and when, and squadron operations books which are particularly useful for details such as particular operations and their crews, aircraft serials and notes.

Combining these sources over a lengthy period, nuggets of information provided a chronology of his uncle's journey through the lengthy RAF training from Blackpool via Babbacombe, Cambridge, Rutland, Shawbury to Harwell. From there a Wellington ferry flight in late 1941 to Gibraltar, Malta to Egypt for operations with 162 squadron gathering wireless transmissions intelligence before being lost on a bombing raid during the first battle of El Alamein in July 1942.




