A MESSAGE FROM OUR VICAR, DAVID

It seems that, at this time of year, Every school run is delayed by ploughs, tractors, and combinesit's harvest!

When Jesus talked about the harvest though, He wasn't just thinking about wheat and barley alone – He was pointing us to something much bigger. In Matthew 9, He says, "The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few." It's His way of reminding us that there are so many people in the world who are ready to hear the good news, but they need someone to share it with them. That's where the church comes in- where you and I come in!

At St Thomas', we're not just a group of people who meet on Sundays - we're part of the body of Christ, called to live out His love in our community. Think of the harvest as Aldridge and beyond - friends, neighbours, families, and even strangers - all of them people who God loves deeply. The church is meant to be the workers in that harvest field, bringing encouragement, hope, and the message of Jesus to those who might be searching for it, even if they don't know it yet. Going- to love, tell and transform!

As a church family here in Aldridge, we're called to lift our eyes and see the harvest around us - and to join in the joy of sharing the life-changing love of Jesus. Come Holy Spirit!
