#### **Questionnaire Results**

Approximately 400 deliveries are made each month in the ecclesiastical parish of Swainby and Potto. We are indebted to the 7 willing people who do this.

We received 51 responses to the questionnaire, 13 of which were online. 4 households did not wish to receive the News, the rest of those who responded did want to have it delivered, and the majority of them were in favour of more local news as well as news from neighbouring villages.

No one was interested in helping to collect village news. 4 people were willing to help with deliveries if necessary, but at present there is no need for more help in that area. Peter Shipp, who now lives in Scarborough has offered digital help.

The majority preferred a letterbox delivery, there were about 13 who would like it to be put online, but some were aware that they might be in the minority and therefore would accept the current system.

So, all in all not much change! One or two people said how pleased they were to get it and one or two thanked us for our efforts.

You will be aware that of the 400 households to whom the Church News is delivered only 51 responded. What do the remaining approximately 350 families feel? Will we ever know? Probably not.

We will continue for the time being, in the hopes that we are of some use to everyone. We do thank all those who made kind remarks about our efforts and we sincerely thank all those who help with the production of the Church News.
