## **Stewardship at St Margaret's**

Recently the PCC has been carefully considering our financial situation, and particularly how we can encourage regular giving and one-off donations to the church. It costs around £3500 every week to operate our church activities, maintain our beautiful buildings, and contribute towards the cost of ministry in less affluent parts of the diocese. We rely entirely on the generosity of our congregation, visitors and supporters, **and we thank each of you once again for your support.**

We have made some changes around the church and hall to advertise our financial position and encourage more people to support us as conveniently as possible, most of which you will see today:

- A new information board at the card reader by the entrance to church.
- Handy leaflets giving information about how to make a regular donation, and how to leave a legacy to the church in your will.
- A new card reader in the hall lobby for those who enter or exit that way, for example when refreshments are served upstairs, and for our regular hall users.
