# Dark times - quiet times?

It's tempting to think that 'not much happens' in November, as we're all too busy planning for the joys of December(!). And although for many people, the month will start with a bang on bonfire night (Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> November), at our churches we'll be marking All Souls and All Saints on Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup>, with special services taking place where we give thanks to God for those who have gone ahead of us – and there will be an opportunity to light candles in memory of our loved ones.

The following weekend, Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> November, sees the traditional Remembrance Sunday services taking place at different times during the day (see the list of services opposite). It's a time to give thanks for the freedom we enjoy because of the sacrifices made on our behalf in times of war, and to pray that we may be agents of peace in a world which so often seems to be heading in the opposite direction.

Prayers for peace and harmony will also be needed with the UN Climate Change Conference, COP30, taking place in Brazil, 10<sup>th</sup>-21<sup>st</sup> November. So many improvements have taken place in this area, but still the world nations are so far away from the targets needed to halt climate change – the results of which could be disastrous for life on our planet. Our prayers and action are needed!

The Sunday following COP, 23<sup>rd</sup> November, all our Flegg Churches will be joining together for the Festival of Christ the King. And the month ends with another important date: Advent Sunday. This year, we're promoting the Archbishop of York's Advent Book, authored by the Bishop of Chelmsford, Guli Francis-Dehqani – a lovely book which includes short studies on topics such as: how angels continue speaking to us today; how fear of what might happen prevents us from living well in the present; how pain and loss can be transformed by the power of beauty; how daring to dwell in darkness and silence can lead to new life; and how important it is to find light and space, signified by the candles of Advent. Do get hold of a copy – and be inspired this Advent!
