Temporary banking hub at the library

Cash Access UK has opened a temporary home for the banking hub in Ilkley at the library on Station Road. Customers of all major banks can visit any weekday between 9.00 am – 5.00 pm to carry out regular cash transactions including cash withdrawals and deposits as well as checking balances or paying bills.

The hub also offers a community banker service where customers can talk to their own bank in a private space about more complicated issues on the day their bank is in the hub: Monday: HSBC (coming soon); Tuesday: Halifax; Wednesday: NatWest; Thursday: Santander; Friday: Barclays.
