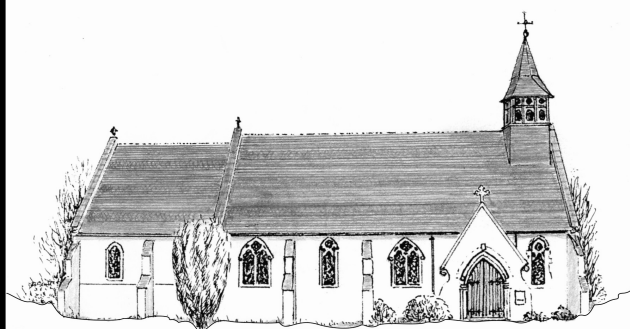

From Rev'd Tom Benson

Dear friends,

Well, here we are in December once again and once again I seem surprised by it. This year has been such a busy one for most of us and this time of year it is always good to take a moment or two just to pause and reflect on all that has happened. Our communities have of course welcomed new people into the fold as well as saying goodbye to some dearly loved friends. For myself, I remember the weddings over the summer, the Timsbury bonfire was another memorable event when everyone came together. Not to forget the way that our churches looked at Harvest and thanks once again to all those people that helped with the preparation for that. Visiting the Primary Schools recently for their Harvest Festival presentations made me realise I'm getting old and my own childrens' schooldays seem so far away now.

In the next few weeks I know many of you, like me, will enjoy attending Nativity plays and tableaux put on in our schools, villages and beyond. We value the traditional hymns and description of Jesus' birth, which follows the same Biblical story, even though most teachers and vicars have a collection of jokes about things children have said or done which don't quite stick to the script.

Yet for many of us, children and adults, its easy to forget that the Nativity story is really quite irrelevant to our lives today, unless we have a grasp of who that small baby in the manger was and what he came to do. After all, the only reason we mark a historic figure's birthday is because of the life they led afterwards. In his relatively short time here on earth he shared the daily life and work of an ordinary home, he went about healing sick and troubled people and teaching small groups in villages, in the fields and by the lakeside gathering 12 ordinary men to be his helpers.

Jesus taught by what he said, by what he was and by what he did. He taught us to trust God, as a loving father, to pray in faith and to be sensitive to the needs of others, and to follow him in lives of generosity, faith, simplicity and love. He taught that we are each infinitely precious to God so we should look out for one another with understanding, respect and forgiveness.

Now I reckon that really is worth celebrating so do have a very Happy Christmas.

Remembering Adrian Fahy

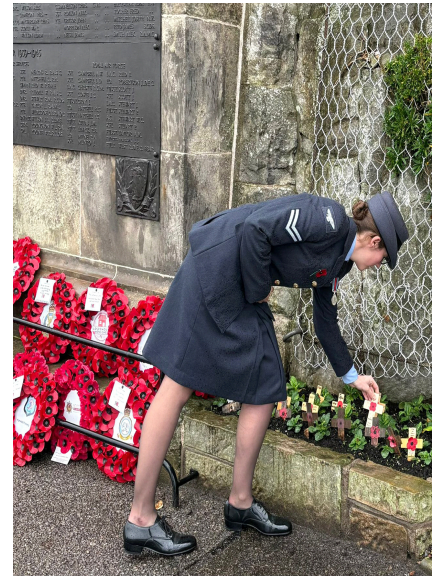
Adrian Fahy grew up in Braishfield, living at Oakrood, The Square, with his parents and three brothers. After leaving school he worked at Tony Broster's garage in Timsbury as a panel beater and sprayer before joining the Royal Air Force, and becoming a Flying Officer.

Adrian was aged 26 and based at RAF Lossiemouth in Scotland when, on 22nd April 1987 he tragically lost his life in a flying accident on a training flight.

His body was never found.

A memorial plaque in All Saints Church, beneath the board bearing the names of those who lost their lives in the First and Second World Wars, commemorates Adrian. And each year, on Remembrance Sunday and Armistice Day Adrian's name is read out at Braishfield War Memorial, as one who lost his life serving his country in peace time.

This year, a cross bearing Adrian's name was placed at the memorial in Lossiemouth by Corporal Benson, Rev Tom and Maryanne's daughter Rosie, who is currently serving there: a special link with his home village.



Landslide in Kasika

An update about the Romsey Deanery partnership with South Rwenzori Diocese, Uganda

A devastating landslide in a remote hill top village in the South Rwenzori mountains - the Mountains of the Moon - has destroyed homes, killed 17 residents and disrupted the flow of clean water from a spring.

These mountains form the barrier between Uganda and DR Congo. The Romsey deanery has for several decades supported the work of the South Rwenzori diocese which runs along this border and includes this mountain range.

The dislocation of families, the rupture of communications and limited access to clean water and fresh food has been the norm since the landslide.

The bishop of South Rwenzori and his team are anxious to raise money for the reconnection of fresh water from the spring to Kasika and the surrounding villages.

The first phase of the work to re-establish clean water is priced at £4,778. If we were able to collect **£3,583** then Gift Aid would provide the difference.

At the deanery synod recently it was suggested from the floor that all churches in the Romsey deanery should be circulated with this urgent need. If 20 churches gave £180 each we would reach our target.

We have so much in the west and this would be an excellent way of giving thanks for the stability and peace we enjoy in our country. If you would like to contribute to this water project please either send a cheque to our treasurer at the address below or use the bank transfer details.

One Man's Journey of Spiritual Thanksgiving

Phil Carr, who worships at St Peter & St Paul, King's Somborne, has always been a keen walker, but pain in his hips while walking led to the discovery of unrelated prostate cancer. This month, Phil embarked on a two day 'walk of thanksgiving' along part of the Camino Way pilgrim's trail from Winchester to Southampton, the two places where he received hospital treatment, praying in gratitude for those who treated him and those who prayed for him.



Last October on a 6 mile walk to see Bishop David bless the new car park at Awbridge Church, Phil suffered debilitating pains in his hips. It became worse over the coming weeks till eventually he could barely walk.

What began as an investigation into hip pain, led to the discovery of unrelated prostate cancer during routine blood tests. The diagnosis required urgent attention and the hip treatment became a secondary concern. He faced a series of tests and consultations at various hospitals and in early March this year he underwent three hour surgery to successfully remove the cancer. That was followed in April by the hip replacement. Phil said, "It took probably another three months before I was mobile again, but I was very thankful for God's healing process and I wanted to show my appreciation for that."

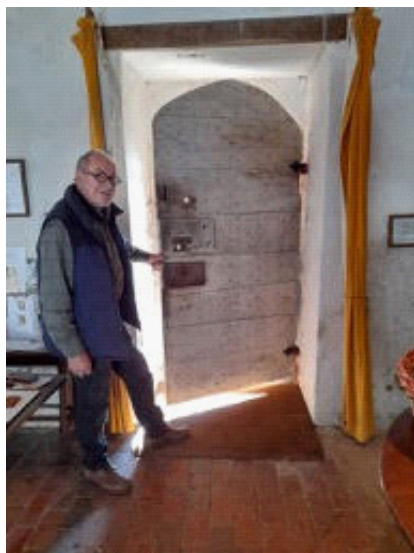

The door returns!

Thursday 16th October was an important day at St John's Farley Chamberlayne. The ancient front door to the church, which had suffered a hinge breakage after goodness knows how many hundred years of use, was finally returned and refitted following a full sympathetic repair by an artisan blacksmith. The door is thought to be an original item that

dates from the 12th Century so great care was taken in managing the repair. The whole building now looks much happier with the proper door back in place. (A temporary one has been there in the interim!)

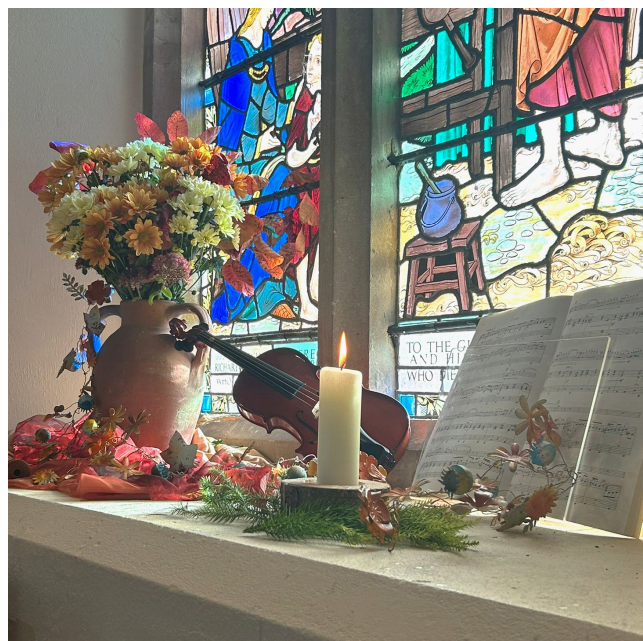


St Cecelia Celebration with the dedication and blessing of the new organ at Awbridge

On Sunday 2nd November the congregation of All Saints was joined by members of congregations across the benefice to fill the church for a special celebration of Holy Communion led by Bishop Philip Mounstephen, Bishop of Winchester. During the service Bishop Philip dedicated the splendid new church organ. He chose the readings for St Cecilia's Day, St Cecilia being the patron saint of music.

At the end of the service, Chris Thompson, Awbridge organist, played the Toccata and Fugue in D Minor BWV 565 by J. S. Bach as the Voluntary. This piece highlighted the musical range of the new organ, which has three manuals and a full pedal board. Refreshments were served following the service and many

people were able to talk to Bishop Philip and his wife Ruth, and meet their dog Noggin!

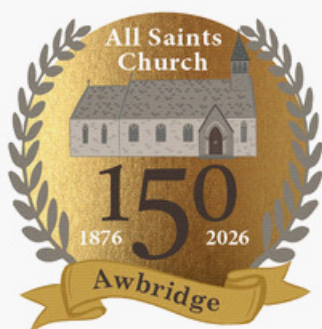
Our last Messy Church was great fun!
